

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1935.

The butter in storage amounts to 22,343,894 pounds of creamery and 284,749 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 15,034,169 pounds are in cold storage plants and 7,309,725 pounds in creameries. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 9.8 % from last year and an increase of 280.0 % over last month. Dairy butter shows increases of 31.7 % over last year and 85.4 % over last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 784,000 pounds as compared with 672,000 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 18,836,233 pounds showing increases of 7.9 % and 59.0% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 7,858,401 dozens; fresh eggs 613,517 dozens; and frozen eggs 3,735,269 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 39.7 % from last year and an increase of 29.1 % over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 12.1 % from last year and an increase of 12.1 % over last month; and frozen eggs show increases of 52.4 % over last year and 37.6 % over last month. In addition to these stocks, car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 235,680 dozens as compared with 279,870 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 2,691,161 pounds; fresh frozen 13,500,765 pounds and cured or in cure 15,949,443 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 5.5 % from last year and 17.8 % last month; fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 39.9 % over last year and a decrease of 16.6 % from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show decreases of 3.4 % from last year and 3.0 % from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,400,175 pounds showing decreases of 7.5 % and 7.8 % from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 4,199,932 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,466,290 pounds of fresh not frozen; 299,139 pounds of cured; and 208,580 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 39.0 % over last year and a decrease of 25.5 % from last month, fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 6.9 % from last year and 13.0% from last month; cured stocks show an increase of 75.8 % over last year and a decrease of 14.6 % from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 51.2 % over last year and a decrease of 2.4 % from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,294,099 pounds of fresh frozen and 550,243 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 40.9 % over last year and 24.3 % over last month and fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 3.9 % from last year and 7.6 % from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 705,422 pounds of frozen and 331,842 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 105.1 % over last year and a decrease of 54.2 % from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 16.8 % over last year and 59.3 % over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 81,717 pounds; chickens 100,652 pounds; fowl 495,287 pounds; ducks 98,903 pounds; geese 61,368 pounds; turkeys 1,461,626 pounds; unclassified 238,567 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 4.4 % and 16.8 % from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 9,826,391 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,347,253 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 5.5 % from last year and an increase of 24.4 % over last month; and smoked and other varieties also show a decrease of 20.2 % from last year and an increase of 4.5 % over last month. During the month of June 3,833,282 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,056,177 frozen during May.
