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





COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1935.

The butter in storage amounts to 51,271,008 pounds of creamery and 868,367 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 39,423,808 pounds are in cold storage plants and 11,847,200 pounds in creameries. Creamery butter shows increases of .8% over last year and 29.6% over last month; and dairy butter also shows increases of 51.4% over last year and 60.1% over last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 980,000 pounds as compared with 868,000 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 34,625,600 pounds showing increases of 7.7% and 19.8% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,075,864 dozens; fresh eggs 427,362 dozens; and frozen eggs 4,221,337 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 31.8% from last year and an increase of 4.8% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 38.3% from last year and an increase of 18.1% over last month, and frozen eggs show increases of 26.0% over last year and .6% over last month. In addition to these stocks car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 117,840 dozens as compared with 176,760 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 2,104,843 pounds; fresh frozen 6,811,833 pounds; and cured or in cure 12,964,052 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 11.8% over last year and a decrease of 18.4% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 47.1% over last year and a decrease of 29.4% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show an increase of .4% over last year and a decrease of 10.5% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,198,481 pounds showing an increase of 43.4% over last year and a decrease of 13.4% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,968,212 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,097,304 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 253,148 pounds of cured, and 236,663 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of .2% over last year and 19.7% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show a decrease of 2.2% from last year and an increase of 2.5% over last month; cured stocks show an increase of 12.2% over last year and a decrease of 14.8% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show a decrease of 20.8% from last year and an increase of 14.3% over last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 1,603,608 pounds of fresh frozen and 483,312 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 12.9% over last year and 9.3% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of .4% over last year and a decrease of 32.4% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 546,463 pounds of frozen and 278,760 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 11.0% over last year and a decrease of 3.9% from last month; and stocks not frozen show decreases of 27.1% from last year and 16.0% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 202,571 pounds; chickens 10,249 pounds; fowl 295,824 pounds; ducks 173,156 pounds; geese 48,917 pounds; turkeys 321,874 pounds; unclassified 180,824 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 27.2% and 23.4% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 20,161,872 pounds of fresh and frozen and 5,356,468 pounds of smoked, dried, salted or pickled. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of .2% over last year and 23.7% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show a decrease of 18.1% from last year and an increase of 9.1% over last month.


