COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1936.

The butter in storage amounts to 24,250,732 pounds of creamery and 121,453 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 17,604,631 pounds are in cold storage plants and 6,646,101 pounds are in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 350,000 pounds contributed by firms in Quebec and Ontario that were added to the list since June 1, 1935. Creamery butter shows an increase of 7.1% over last year and a decrease of 24.3% from last month and dairy butter shows decreases of 61.6% and 39.0% from last year and last month respectively. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 520,800 pounds as compared with 303,000 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 21,957,173 pounds showing an increase of 43.2% over last year and a decrease of 9.9% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 525,713 dozen; fresh eggs 423,940 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,092,926 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 7.03% from last year and 57.1% from last month; fresh eggs show increases of 36.0% over last year and 31.2% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 36.6% over last year and a decrease of 17.4% from last month. In addition to these stocks, car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 44,190 dozen, exactly the same as shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,409,330 pounds; fresh frozen 13,430,315 pounds, cured or in cure 15,973,441 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 12.2% from last year and an increase of 25.6% over last month; fresh frozen stocks show increases of 34.7% over last year and 8.4% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show increases of .8% over last year and 6.5% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,609,231 pounds showing increases of 49.9% and 5.9% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 13,328,727 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,271,916 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 371,134 pounds of cured; and 265,059 pounds in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 8.2% from last year and 20.3% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of .2% from last year and an increase of 35.1% over last month; cured stocks show increases of 3.9% over last year and 31.0% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 21.7% over last year and a decrease of .4% from last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 1,851,135 pounds of fresh frozen and 328,886 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 28.2% over last year and a decrease of 29.2% from last month; and fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 19.6% from last year and an increase of 36.2% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,506,945 pounds of frozen and 267,966 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 22.8% from last year and 15.2% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 6.9% over last year and 2.0% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 137,465 pounds; chickens 5,239,059 pounds; fowl 1,577,685 pounds; ducks 112,348 pounds; geese 166,482 pounds; turkeys 3,274,593 pounds; unclassified 537,794 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of .1% and 6.3% from last year and last month respectively. Car-loads of poultry reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned amount to 122,000 pounds as compared with 66,000 pounds shown last month.

Fish stocks total 16,673,574 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,868,663 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled and salted. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 7.0% over last year and a decrease of 21.1% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 14.3% from last year and 13.2% from last month.
