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

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1, 1936.

The butter in storage amounts to 16,189,759 pounds of creamery and 92,092 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 11,515,285 pounds are in cold storage plants and 4,674,474 pounds in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 320,000 pounds contributed by firms that were added to the list since June 1, 1935. Creamery butter shows an increase of 7.7% over last year and a decrease of 34.2% from last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 68.8% from last year and 24.2% from last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 632,800 pounds as compared with 520,800 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 19,037,867 pounds showing an increase of 46.6% over last year and a decrease of 13.0% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 6,270 dozens; fresh eggs 86,955 dozens; and frozen eggs 1,640,511 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 98.9% from last year and 99.2% from last month; fresh eggs also show decreases of 67.4% from last year and 79.5% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 12.1% over last year and a decrease of 21.8% from last month. In addition to these stocks, car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 29,460 dozens as compared with 44,190 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,413,700 pounds, fresh frozen 14,920,682 pounds, cured or in cure 17,326,111 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 18.0% from last year and .01% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show increases of 17.9% over last year and 11.0% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show increases of 6.5% and 7.0% over last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,792,458 pounds showing decreases of 14.0% and 24.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 9,962,779 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,225,620 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 444,465 pounds of cured; and 277,161 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 11.4% from last year and 25.3% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 20.3% over last year and a decrease of 1.1% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 33.5% and 20.6% over last year and last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 57.2% and 2.2% over last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,127,465 pounds of fresh frozen and 498,242 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 19.3% over last year and a decrease of 39.1% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show increases of 47.7% over last year and 51.0% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,379,142 pounds of frozen and 241,404 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 34.6% from last year and 25.0% from last month and stocks, not frozen also show decreases of 16.2% from last year and 10.0% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:-broilers 157,577 pounds; chickens 4,777,080 pounds; fowl 1,068,779 pounds; ducks 95,759 pounds; geese 145,678 pounds; turkeys 3,259,356 pounds; unclassified 469,129 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 5.7% over last year and a decrease of 12.5% from last month. Car-loads of poultry reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 66,000 pounds as compared with 122,000 pounds shown last month.

Fish stocks total 12,780,037 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,153,506 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of .6% from last year and 23.1% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show decreases of 20.9% and 19.9% from last year and last month respectively.
