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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, APRIL 1, 1936.

The butter in storage amounts to 8,511,628 pounds of creamery and 52,655 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 5,631,366 pounds are in cold storage plants and 2,880,262 pounds are in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 200,000 pounds contributed by firms that were added to the list since June 1, 1935. Creamery butter shows an increase of 19.8% over last year and a decrease of 46.7% from last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 79.8% from last year and 42.8% from last month. Carloads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 224,000 pounds as compared with 632,800 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,640,047 pounds showing an increase of 27.8% over last year and a decrease of 14.5% from last month. These figures include approximately 180,000 pounds of cheese reported by firms added to the list since January 1, 1936.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 63,132 dozens; fresh eggs 320,076 dozens; and frozen eggs 1,234,497 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 80.3% from last year and an increase of 906.9% over last month; fresh eggs also show a decrease of 44.6% from last year and an increase of 275.2% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 7.1% over last year and a decrease of 24.7% from last month. In addition to these stocks, car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 132,570 dozens as compared with 29,460 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: - fresh not frozen 3,544,071 pounds; fresh frozen 15,198,429 pounds; cured or in cure 17,891,646 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show increases of .9% over last year and 4.0% over last month; fresh frozen stocks also show increases of 1.8% over last year and 4.2% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show a decrease of 1.6% from last year and an increase of 3.3% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,912,916 pounds showing a decrease of 18.3% from last year and an increase of 5.0% over last month.

Beef stocks total 10,119,335 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,703,644 pounds of fresh not frozen; 396,117 pounds of cured; and 352,123 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 10.1% over last year and 1.6% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 10.2% over last year and a decrease of 8.3% from last month; cured stocks show an increase of .1% over last year and a decrease of 10.9% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 138.4% and 27.1% over last year and last month respectively.


The veal in storage amounts to 920,608 pounds of fresh frozen and 557,766 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 29.2% over last year and a decrease of 18.3% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks also show an increase of 38.4% over last year and an increase of 12.0% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,604,222 pounds of frozen and 217,974 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 39.1% from last year and 22.9% from last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 8.0% over last year and a decrease of 9.7% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: - broilers 143,522 pounds; chickens 4,246,761 pounds; fowl 650,217 pounds; ducks 78,303 pounds; geese 124,568 pounds; turkeys 3,035,949 pounds; unclassified 428,598 pounds. The total poultry shows an increase of 14.3% over last year and a decrease of 12.3% from last month. Car-loads of poultry reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the above figures, amount to 22,000 pounds as compared with 66,000 pounds shown last month.

Fish stocks total 11,023,941 pounds of fresh and frozen and 3,324,739 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show an increase of 27.2% over last year and a decrease of 14.9% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 5.2% from last year and an increase of 5.3% over last month.
