





COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1936.

The butter in storage amounts to 10,663,921 pounds of creamery and 36,317 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 5,234,383 pounds are in cold storage plants and 5,423,140 pounds are in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 1,012,000 pounds contributed by firms that were added to the list since June 1, 1935. Creamery butter shows increases of 73.8% over last year and 109.0% over last month; and dairy butter shows a decrease of 76.4% from last year and an increase of 4.9% over last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the figures just mentioned, amount to 532,000 pounds as compared with 140,000 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 14,388,811 pounds showing an increase of 19.9% over last year and a decrease of .1% from last month. These figures include approximately 1,449,000 pounds of cheese reported by firms that were added to the list since January 1, 1936.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 6,847,477 dozens, fresh eggs 482,483 dozens; and frozen eggs 2,643,193 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 9.2% over last year and 203.5% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 36.5% from last year and 20.4% from last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 5.1% from last year and an increase of 102.2% over last month. In addition to these stocks, car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, amount to 324,060 dozens as compared with 176,760 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,242,027 pounds; fresh frozen 16,470,439 pounds; cured or in cure 17,621,495 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 1.2% from last year and 19.2% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show increases of 1.6% over last year and .4% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show increases of 7.0% over last year and 5.1% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,728,572 pounds showing increases of 1.3% and 8.8% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 7,834,522 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,812,953 pounds of fresh not frozen; 710,376 pounds of cured; and 379,198 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 38.1% over last year and a decrease of 14.7% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 6.3% from last year and 11.1% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 102.6% over last year and 157.3% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show an increase of 77.5% over last year and a decrease of 28.1% from last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 1,822,426 pounds of fresh frozen and 721,150 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 73.1% over last year and 48.2% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks also show increases of 20.8% and 3.3% over last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 643,229 pounds of frozen and 111,829 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 58.3% from last year and 56.4% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 46.4% from last year and 39.1% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 98,812 pounds; chickens 2,490,750 pounds; fowl 280,565 pounds; ducks 85,836 pounds; geese 118,162 pounds; turkeys 2,226,429 pounds; unclassified 98,346 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 24.7% over last year and a decrease of 20.2% from last month. Car-loads of poultry reported by the railways in transit or at terminals, and not included in the above figures, amount to 44,000 pounds the same as shown last month. Included in the former figures is one car of mixed butter and poultry weighing 22,000 pounds.

Fish stocks total 11,004,106 pounds of fresh and frozen and 4,752,462 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 34.4% over last year and 17.1% over last month; and smoked and other varieties also show increases of 21.2% and 12.1% over last year and last month respectively.


