15/52/4 32.0.01 COLD STORAGE REPORT FOR APRIL 1, 1919. The Cost of Living Branch of the Labour Department reports as follows to the Honourable Minister of Labour concerning stocks of food in storage on April First. The total amount of Creamery Butter in storage on April 1st, was 1,773,290 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 69% less than last month and 172% less than last year. The quantity of Dairy butter in storage amounts to 116,963 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 72% less than last month and 76% less than last year. The butter market has been subject to a great increase of prices since our last report, this being due partially to an increased abternational price, rising to higher levels even than the present Canadian price, and to the shortage of supply in Canada at the present time. Such a shortage was not anticipated owing to the fact that on the first of March we had in storage 48% more butter than the previous March. Some butter has found its way out of Canada during the past month, but, apparently, only in comparatively small shipments. No accurate data will be available on this until the Custom's figures are published in the latter part of the month. Apparently, the increasing price on the international market has stimulated a more rapid handling of butter in Canada this spring than last spring. There is no reason to suppose that the increased price of this year is due to any cause contrary to the laws which exist. The quantity of Olecmargarine in storage on April 1st, was 339,347 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 37½% less than on March 1st. No figures are available for a year ago. This is a small quantity compared with our normal monthly consumption of oleomargarine, but should have no effect upon the price owing to the fact that oleomargarine is a product manufactured evenly throughout the year and is not stored for any season of scant production.


The quantity of cheese in storage on April: 1st, was 1,499,952 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 38% less than a month ago and 63% less than a year ago.

The eggs in cold storage amount to only 105,030 dozen, which is even  $36\frac{1}{4}$  less than last month in spite of the fact tha new eggs are already going into storage. The comparison figures show  $70\frac{1}{2}\%$  less in store this April than a year ago. The eggs on hand other than in cold storage amount to 356,067 dozen. Comparison figures show this to be an increase of  $84\frac{1}{2}\%$  over last month and  $51\frac{1}{4}\%$  over last year. Frozen eggs amount to 340,974 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be  $41\frac{1}{2}\%$  less than last month and 612% more than last year.

The total quantity of rork in storage amounts to 38,233,491 pounds. Of this 6,319,122 was frozen pork. Comparison figures show this to be 12 % less than a month ago and 20 1/3 % less than a year ago. Unfrozen fresh pork amounts to 2,448,321 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 30 % less than a month ago and 20% less than a year ago. Dry salted pork amounts to 4,389,004 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 6 1/3 % less than a month ago and 14% more than a year ago. Sweet pickled pork in storage amounts to 11,581,966 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 45% less than last month and 82% less than year ago. The trade should note these final figures instead of the preliminary figures sent out on April 12th, in which an error occurred. The pork in process of cure amounts to 13,495,078 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 43% less than last month and 3 2/3 % less than a year ago.

The total quantity of beef in storage amounts to 44,464,311 pounds. Of this, frozen beef amounts to 41,333,481. Comparison figures show this to be 61% less than last month and 89 1/3 % more than a year ago. Unfrozen fresh beef amounts to 1,968,687 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 47½% less than a month ago and 40% less than a year ago. Cured beef in storage amounts to 710,689 pounds comparison figures show this to be 10% more than a month ago and 9% less than a year ago. Beef in process of cure amounts to 451,454 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 33% more than a month ago and 222% more than a year ago.

The total amount of mutton and lamb in cold storage on April 1st, was 4, 456,280 pounds. Of this, 4,428,733 pounds was frozen. Comparison figures show this to be 362/3 % less than a month ago and 113 % more than a year ago. Unfrozen mutton and lamb amounts to 27,547 pounds. Comparison figures show this to be 73% % less than a month ago and substantially the same as a year ago.

The total poultry for this month amounts to 3.880,408. Comparison figures show this to be 20½% less than a month ago and 144% more than a year ago. Of this, the majority has been classified, but 605,662 pounds have not yet been classified. The amounts classified are as follows:

The total amount of fish in storage is 22.623.816 pounds. Comparison figures show to be 4 1/3 % less than a month ago and 48 1/3 % more than a year ago. Of this, 18,942,709 pounds are in cold storage and 3,681,106 pounds are on hand other than in cold storage.

Note:- Owing to an error in a report made to us by one of the largest firms, the report for last month should be revised, adding to the total quantity of fresh frozen pork 335,841 pounds, in Saskatchewan, and to fresh frozen beef 55,704 pounds. This should be added to the total for Saskatchewan and the Dominion.


