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Jan, 19, 1920.

The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics published the following report concerning stocks of food in Cold Storage and in process of cure on January 1, 1920:-

The butter in storage on January the first, amounted to 14,659,223 pounds of creamery and 806,193 of dairy. Comparative figures show this, in the case of creamery butter to be 22.77% more than the corresponding month of last year, and 18.61% less than last month, and, in the case of dairy butter to be 40.69% less than last January and 17.65% less than last month.

The oleomargarine in storage amounts to 726,234 pounds. Comparative figures show this to be 6.38% less than last January and 69.67% more than last month.

The cheese in storage amounts to 27,204,039 pounds. While this is shown to be .58 of 1% less than last month, it is 511.77% more than last year.

The eggs in cold storage amount to 2,902,116 dozen. Comparative figures show a decline of 50.47% from last month and an increase of 36.83% over January 1919. Eggs other than cold storage amount to 380,852 dozen. Frozen eggs amount to 377,932 pounds, 19.92% less than last month and 80.47% less than last year.

The pork stocks are 3,563,226 pounds of frozen; 1,217,813 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 1,671,554 pounds dry salted; 5,355,099 pounds of sweet pickled and 10,644,077 pounds in process of cure. This latter quantity is not in cold storage and is nearly one-half of the total. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen decreased 27.30% as compared with the last year and increased 79.84% over last month; fresh unfrozen decreased 51.64% from last year and decreased 45.01% from last month's figures; dry salted decreased 50.09% from last year and 5.69% from last month; sweet pickled decreased 58.66% from last January but increased 17.83% over December 1919; in process of cure is 37.59% less than last month and 29.53% less than last year. The total is 18.65% less than last month and 42.20% less than last year.

The beef stocks amount to 45,025,859 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,581,370 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 547,294 pounds cured; and 272,023 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures are as follows:- fresh frozen has increased 14.31% since last month but is 12.19% less than January, 1919; fresh unfrozen is 41.37% less than last month and .84 of 1% less than last year; cured beef has increased 131.04% over last month but has decreased 1.02% from last year; beef stocks in process of cure have decreased 27.62% since last month and are 67.80% less than last year; the total beef has increased 5.30% since last month but has decreased 12.08% over January 1919.

Stocks of mutton and lamb amount to 7,182,612 pounds of which 6,950,535 are frozen and 232,077 are unfrozen. Comparative figures show a decrease of 20.12% compared with last years.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 557,002 pounds, chickens 2,341,877 pounds, fowl 1,339,008 pounds, ducks 89,518 pounds, geese 90,813 pounds, turkeys 442,505 pounds, unclassified 322,211 pounds, total 4,982,934 pounds. The total is 15.13% less than last January but 33.04% more than 1st. December 1919. Changes from last month are as follows:- Broilers increased 105.72%; chickens 59.54%; fowl 21.64%; ducks 39.14%; geese decreased 3.83%; turkeys increased 26.28%; unclassified poultry decreased 40.37%.

Fish stocks continue to show a decline. On January 1st cold storage stocks amounted to 17,930,279 pounds, and 2,482,239 were on hand other than in cold storage. Total fish stocks thus amount to 20,412,578 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease of cold storage stocks from last month of 17.51% and a decrease of 1.27% of other than cold storage stocks. The total shows a decrease of 14.85% from January 1, 1919.
