The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on December 1, 1920:-

The butter in storage on December 1st amounted to 20,032,536 pounds of creamery and 1,159,036 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery butter to be 10.93% more than last year and 19.28% less than last month, and in the case of dairy butter to be 20.75% more than last December and 12.36% more than on November 1.

The Oleomargarine in storage amounts to 583,159 pounds, an increase of 18.74% over last year and a decrease of 14.84% from last month.

The cheese in storage amounts to 15,831,100 pounds. This shows a decrease of 42.13% from last year and 15.99% from last month.

The egg stocks are 4,456,104 dozen in cold storage, 350,992 dozen other than cold storage and 1,169,944 pounds of frozen. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 23.81% from last year and 51.19% from last month.

The Pork stocks are 2,619,393 pounds of frozen; 2,390,415 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 1,770,125 pounds dry salted; 10,908,685 pounds sweet pickled; and 11,061,639 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen increased 32.47% from last year and 29.02% from last month; fresh unfrozen decreased 2.82% as compared with last year and increased 7.22% from last month; dry salted shows decrease of .86% from last December and an increase of 20.14% from November 1, Sweet pickled has increased 92.69% from last year and 31.21% from last month; in process of cure, there is a decrease of 37.26% from last year and an increase of 22.32% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 30,886,778 pounds of which 19,712,047 pounds are fresh frozen, 10,611,168 pounds fresh unfrozen, 376,702 pounds cured, and 186,861 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has decreased 12.85% from last year and increased 41.44% from last month, fresh unfrozen has increased 33.6% in comparison with last year and 129.5%, in comparison with last month, cured beef shows an increase of 56.77% over last year and a decrease of 34.90% from last month; in process of cure decreased 31.28% from last year and 42.55% from last month.

Stocks of Mutton and Lamb amount to 7,686,976 of which 7,169,54 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show a decrease in the total stocks of 6.12% from last year and an increase of 76.08% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 175,575 pounds, chickens 884,995 pounds, fowl 696,688 pounds, ducks 44,431 pounds, geese 74,022 pounds, turkeys 241,961 pounds, unclassified 678,219 pounds.

Fish stocks show a total of 22,275,461 pounds of which 19,706,390 pounds are in cold storage and 2,569,171 pounds other than cold storage. Comparative figures for cold storage stocks show practically the same holdings as last year and a decrease of 5.06% from last month.


