The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce, publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on April 1, 1920:-

The Butter in storage on April 1st, amounted to 3,980,161 pounds of creamery and 411,202 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery butter to be 122.99% more than last year and 47.82% less than last month and in the case of dairy butter to be 251.40% more than last year and 5.87 per cent less than last month.

The Oleomargarine in storage amounts to 616,430 pounds. Comparative figures show this to be 80.97% more than last April and 18.2% less than the previous month.

The Cheese stocks amount to 11,163,329 pounds while this is shown by comparative figures to be 641.25% more than last year, it is 8.16% less than last month.

The Eggs in cold storage amount to 148,949 dozen. Comparative figures show a decline of 29.95% from last month and 39.07% more than last year. Eggs other than cold storage amount to 368,437 dozen. Frozen eggs amount to 237,475 pounds, 30.42% less than last year and 9.66% less than last month.

The Pork stocks are 8,758,732 pounds of frozen, 1,965,445 pounds of unfrozen, 1,990,569 pounds of dry salted, 10,981,701 pounds of sweet pickled and 10,698,389 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has increased 13.12% over last month and 38.57% over last year, fresh unfrozen shows a decrease of 20.92% from last month and 19.2% from last year, dry salted has increased 13.84% from last month but decreased 54.65% from last year; sweet pickled shows a decrease of 10.09% from March 1st, and 5.18% from last April, in process of cure the decrease from last year is 20.72% and from last month 1½%; the total being 1.84% less than last month and 10.05% less than the previous year.

The Beef stocks amount to 34,301,314 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks are 29,124,924 pounds, fresh unfrozen 3,138,153 pounds, cured 1,734,338 pounds, in process of cure 303,899 pounds. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has decreased 13% since last month and 29.6% since last year; fresh unfrozen increased 37.47% from March 1st and 60% from last April, cured decreased 15% from last month but increased 144% from last year, stocks in process of cure decreased 32.68% from last year but show an increase of 3.57% from last month, the total decreased 9.5% from last month and 22.9% from last year.

Stocks of Mutton & Lamb amount to 2,222,743 pounds of which 2,189,575 pounds are frozen and 33,168 pounds unfrozen. Comparative figures show a decrease of 38.95% from last month.

Stocks of Poultry are as follows:- Broilers 194,116 pounds, Chickens 1,445,107 pounds, Fowl 538,655 pounds, Ducks 63,589 pounds, Geese 52,047 pounds, Turkeys 268,793 pounds, Unclassified 463,696 pounds.

Fish stocks are 11,337,123 pounds in cold storage and 2,036,795 pounds other than cold storage. Comparative figures show a decrease of 41.35% from last year and 6.05% from last month.
