The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce, publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on May 1, 1920:-

The butter in storage on May 1, amounted to 1,438,688 pounds of creamery and 122,487 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery butter to be 73.46% more than last year and 64.32% less than last month.

The Oleomargarine in storage amounts to 632,108 lbs. Comparative figures show this to be 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>% more than last year and 2.5% more than on April first.

The Cheese stocks amount to 8,940,198 pounds, while this is shown by comparative figures to be 708.6% more than last year, it is 17.08% less than last month.

The Eggs in cold storage amount to 2,244,180 dozen. Comparative figures show a decline of 13.28% from last year but an increase of 1409.87% from last month. Eggs other than cold storage amount to 587,307 dozen while there are 179,436 pounds of frozen eggs.

The Pork stocks are 8,974,330 pounds of frozen, 2,180,753 pounds not frozen, 1,821,713 pounds dry salted, 8,868,116 pounds of sweet pickled and 15,145,451 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following- fresh frozen has increased 103.5% from last year and 2.46% from last month, fresh unfrozen has decreased 32.62% from last year but shows an increase of 10.95% from April 1st; dry salted has decreased 49.36% from last year and 7.79% from last month; sweet pickled shows a decrease of 29.46% from last year and 19.19% from last month; in process of cure has increased 3% over last year and 41.56% over last month. The total being 3.93% less than last year and 7.61% more than last month.

The Beef Stocks amount to 26,506,062 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks are 21,975,338 pounds; fresh unfrozen 2,205,190 pounds; cured 1,839,531 pounds; in process of cure 496,003 pounds. Comparative figures show the following:- Fresh frozen has decreased 33.68% from last year and 24.54% from April 1st., fresh unfrozen increased 13.03% from last year and decreased 29<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>% from last month, cured beef shows an increase of 93% over last year and 6% over last month, in process of cure there is a decrease of 90.5% from the previous year and an increase of 60% from the previous month; the total decreased 35.6% from last year and 22.72% from last month.

Stocks of Mutton & Lamb amount to 1,261,866 pounds of which 1,238,643 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show a decline in frozen stocks of 43.33% from last month and 56.12% from last year, while unfrozen has decreased 29.99% from last month and 25.43% from last year.

Stocks of Poultry are as follows:- Broilers 153,496 pounds; Chickens 1,024,546 pounds; Fowl 384,847 pounds; Ducks 50,002 pounds; Geese 39,849 pounds; Turkeys 224,413 pounds; Unclassified 419,022 pounds

Fish stocks 11,644,584 pounds in cold storage and 3,612,651 pounds of other than cold storage. Comparative figures show a decrease of cold storage stocks of 30.05% from last year and an increase of 2.96% from last month.
