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BUREAU OF STATISTICS

The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on June 1, 1920.

The butter in storage on Junel, amounts to 2,086,915 pounds of creamery and 121,726 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery butter to be 2.97% more than last year and 40% more than last month.

The oleomargarine in storage amounts to 659,246 pounds. Comparative figures show this to be 87.75% more than last year and 5.84% more than last month.

The cheese stocks amount to 3,701,023 lbs, while this is shown by comparative figures to be 24% more than last year, it is 59% less than on May first.

The eggs in cold storage are 7,891,663 dozen, other than cold storage 847,808 dozen and frozen 205,123 bbs. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 250.17% from last month and 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ % from last year.

The pork stocks are 9,186,655 pounds of frozen; 2,887,810 pounds unfrozen, 2,287,993 pounds of dry salted, 6,117,781 pounds sweet pickled and 14,616,129 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has increased 80.82% from last year and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ % from last month, fresh unfrozen shows an increase of 34 $1\frac{2}{3}$ % from last year and 32.44% from last month; dry salted has increased 3% from 1919 and 26% from May first; sweet pickled has decreased 32% from last year and 30 $1\frac{1}{3}$ % from last month; in process of cure has decreased 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ % from last month and 12.05% from last year. The total being 4.87% less than last month.

The beef stocks amount to 16,568,004 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks are 12,830,572 pounds; not frozen 2,475,478 pounds; cured 942,900 pounds; in process of cure 319,054 pounds. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has decreased 43% from last year and 41.60% from last month; fresh unfrozen has increased 12% from last month and 2% from last year; cured beef shows an increase 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ % from last year and a decrease of 48.75% from last month; in process of cure there is a decrease of 27.37% from 1919 and 34.36% from May first.

Stocks of mutton and lamb amount to 1,378,594 pounds of which 1,110,026 pounds are frozen and 268,568 pounds unfrozen. Comparative figures show a decline in total of 32% from last year and an increase of 9% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 112,443 pounds, chickens 788,960 pounds, fowl 303,606 pounds, ducks 48,437 pounds, geese 29,174 pounds, turkeys 182,951 pounds, unclassified 258,383 pounds.

Fish stocks are 13,189,895 pounds in cold storage and 3,140,534 pounds of other than cold storage. Comparative figures show a decrease of cold storage stocks of 12% from last year and an increase of 12% from last month.


