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The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade & Commerce, publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on July 1, 1920 :-

The Butter in storage on July 1st. amounted to 8,058,657 pounds of creamery and 372,435 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery butter to be 22½% less than last year and 315% more than last month, and in the case of dairy butter to be 62.78% less than last year and 204.34% more than last month.

The Oleomargarine in storage amounts to 539,133 pounds. Comparative figures show this to be 19.32% less than on June 1, and 30.67% more than last year.

The Cheese in storage amounts to 8,919,565 pounds, this is shown by comparative figures to be 4.22% less than last year and 144% more than last month.

The Eggs in cold storage amount to 11,331,205 dozen. Comparative figures show an increase of 51% over last month and 7.6% over last year. Eggs other than cold storage amount to 414,667 dozen, while frozen eggs show a total of 344,086 pounds.

The Pork stocks are 9,282,699 pounds of frozen, 2,194,697 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 2,540,295 pounds of dry salted, 7,208,398 pounds of sweet pickled and 20,747,046 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following :- fresh frozen has increased 11.27% from last month and 44-1-3% from last year; fresh unfrozen decreased 23.47% from last month and is 6% less than last July; dry salted increased 11% from last month and 1.39% from last year; sweet pickled decreased 18% from last year and increased 16.33% from last month; in process of cure shows an increase of 42% from June 1st. and 6% from last year; the total being 22.42% more than last month and 5.83% more than last year.

The Beef stocks amount to 6,611,656 pounds of fresh frozen; 1,892,243 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 667,272 pounds of cured and 237,312 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has decreased 42.34% from last month and 58% from last year; not frozen increased 7% over last year but decreased 23.3% from last month; cured, increased 10.44% from last year and decreased 29¼% from last month; in process of cure decreased 40% from last year and 24% from last month; the total being 49% less than last year and 38% less than last month.

Stocks of Mutton and Lamb amount to 1,081,582 pounds of which 972,479 pounds are frozen and 109,103 pounds fresh unfrozen. Comparative figures show an increase in the total of 21½% from last month and 32.32% from last month.

Stocks of Poultry are as follows:- broilers 124,615 pounds; chickens 439,493 pounds; fowl 191,121 pounds; ducks 39,363 pounds; geese 19,531 pounds; turkeys 144,492 pounds; unclassified 140,361 pounds. Broilers have increased 10.46% from last month, while the following show decreases from last month, chickens 41.42%, fowl 29.41%, ducks 18.73%, geese 33.06%, turkeys 21.11%, unclassified 29.42%

Stocks of Fish in cold storage are 13,695,124 pounds and 4,736,922 pounds of fish other than cold storage. Comparative figures show an increase of 5.33% over last month in cold storage stocks and 50.83% increase in other than cold storage stocks.
