

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - October 1, 1921.

#### General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 22,832,559 pounds of creamery and 800,234 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 9.85% in the case of creamery and 28.60% in the case of dairy from the amounts held in storage for the corresponding month last year. Comparisons with last month however show an increase of 11.56% in creamery though a decrease of 16.04% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 187,964 pounds a decrease of

69.28% from last year and 36.75% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 23,818,422 pounds an increase of 19.02% from last October and 16.31% from September first.

Eggs in cold storage total 10,674,500 dozen, other than cold storage 267,599 dozen, frozen 628,769 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage 267,599 dozen, frozen 628,769 pounds.

cold storage 267,599 dozen, frozen 628,769 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 18.09% from last year and 4.18% from last month. Other than cold storage eggs decreased 56.25% from last year and 39.56% from last month. Frozen eggs show a decrease of 46% from last year and 5.02% from last month.

Pork Stocks are as follows:— 2,302,233 pounds of fresh frozen; 1,580,431 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 1,438,968 pounds of cured dry salted; 4,620,874 pounds of cured sweet pickled and 6,281,169 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease of 34.80% from last year and 39.09% from last month, in frozen pork; unfrozen pork has increased 35.73% from last month, in frozen pork; unfrozen pork has increased 35.73% from last year and 25.81% from last month; dry salted pork decreased 15.65% from last year and 38.90 from last month; in process of cure decreased 22.99% from last year and .86% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,614,215 pounds a decrease of 15.42% from last month.

of 15.42% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 6,111,122 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,305,845 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 351,393 pounds of cured and 178,814 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following;— fresh frozen has increased 42.18% from last year and decreased 3.60% from last month; fresh unfrozen had decreased 26.92% from last year and 2.14% from last month, cured shows a decrease of 45.90% from last year and an increase of 3.50% from last month. In process of cure has decreased 26.85% from last year and 23.19% from last month last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 2,191,265 pounds of which 1,799,998 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show an increase of total stocks of 10.43% from last year and 59.68% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows; broilers 175,492 pounds, chickens 150,310 pounds, fowl 196,842 pounds, ducks 42,444 pounds, geese 9,241 pounds, turkeys 12,989 pounds, unclassified 119,857 pounds. The total of 707,155 pounds is an increase of 76.55% from last year and 23.66% from last month.

Fish stocks show 19,508,105 pounds in cold storage and 1,181,529 pounds other than cold storage. Cold Storage stocks have increased 3.74% from last month and decreased 9.21% from last year; other than cold storage increased 24.50% from September first and decreased 47.37% from the corresponding month last year.
