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COLD STORAGE REPORT FOR APRIL 1, 1921.

Stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure on APRIL 1st, 1921.

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April 25, 1921

The Internal Trade Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes the following report concerning stocks of food in cold storage and in process of cure in April 1, 1921.

The butter in storage on April 1st, amounted to 2,396,123 pounds of creamery and 455,169 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery to be 39.8% less than last year and 57.56% less than last month, while dairy butter show an increase of 110% from last year and a decrease of 21.92% from last month.

The oleomargarine in storage amounts to 305,360 pounds showing a decline of 59.47% from last year and of 11.57% from last month.

The cheese in storage amounts to 1,143,252 pounds a decrease of 89.76% from last year and 52.14% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 504,691 dozen, other than cold storage 518,993 dozen and frozen 610,855 pounds. Cold storage stocks show an increase of 238.16% from last year and 592.9% from last month.

The pork stocks show 14,149,774 pounds of fresh frozen, 1,868,443 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 1,771,550 pounds of dry salted, 11,221,574 pounds of sweet pickled and 9,686,633 pounds in process of cure. The total being 38,697,974 pounds. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen has increased 61.55% from last year and 27.59% from last month; fresh unfrozen decreased 4.94% from last year and 31.52% from last month; dry salted decreased 11.01% from last year but increased 2.04% over last month; sweet pickled increased 2.18% from last year and decreased 12.29% from March 1st; in process of cure decreased 9.460% from last year and 2.35% from last month.

Stocks of lard show 2,498,286 pounds, a decrease of 7.43% from last month.

The beef stocks amount to 17,279,345 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,963,958 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 841,512 pounds of cured, 124,777 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen decreased 40.68% from last year and 7.37% from last month, fresh unfrozen decreased 5.56% from last April and 32.29% from last month; cured beef decreased 51.48% from last year and increased 18.41% from March 1st; in process of cure decreased 38.17% from last year and 32.23% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks show 6,489,036 pounds of frozen and 41,982 pounds not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 196.36% from last year but a decrease of 14.05% from last month.

Total stocks of poultry are 2,610,124 pounds which is made up of 142,599 pounds of broilers, 1,113,654 pounds of chickens, 658,717 pounds of fowl, 25,157 pounds of ducks, 26,350 pounds of geese, 124,933 pounds of turkeys and 518,734 pounds of unclassified.

Fish stocks total 16,656,443 pounds of which 13,507,299 pounds are in cold storage and 3,149,144 pounds other than cold storage. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage of fish 19114% from last year and a decrease of 8.9% from last month.


