COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - OCTOBER 1, 1922.

## GENERAL SUMMARY.

The butter in storage amounts to 23,939,369 pounds of creamery and 404,079 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 4.85% in the case of creamery and a decrease of 49.50% in dairy, from the amount held in storage for corresponding date last year. Comparisons with last month show an increase of 4.13% in creamery butter and 10.60% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 133,212 pounds, a decrease of 29.67% from last year and an increase of 21.17% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 16,490,150 pounds a decrease of 22.3% from last year and 11.70% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 14,750,164 dozen, other than cold storage 365,216 dozen, frozen 1,433,457 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 30.18% over last year and a decrease of 1.56% from last month; other than cold storage stocks increased 36.45% over corresponding date of last year and 16.16% over last month, frozen eggs show an increase of 135.93% over last year and 12.22% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 2,266,225 pounds, fresh not frozen 1,910,645 pounds, cured dry salted 1,002,334 pounds, cured sweet pickled 5,305,160 pounds, in process of cure 7,350,517 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen pork stocks to have decreased 61% from same date last year and 44.80% from first of last month; not frozen pork shows an increase of 20.69% over last year and a decrease of 14.46% from last month; dry salted stocks increased 30.01% from last year and decreased .90% from last month; sweet pickled increased 36.45% from last year and 1.69% from last month; pork in process of cure increased 17.15% from last year and decreased 25.06% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,593,247 pounds, a decrease of 1.30% from last year and 2.59% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 19,070,811 pounds of fresh frozen, 5,019,699 pounds of fresh not frozen, 222,463 pounds of cured and 127,139 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen shows an increase of 64.79% over last year and 52.15% over last month; fresh not frozen increased 51.65% over last year and 44.43% over last month; cured beef decreased 36.69% from last year and increased 62.70% from last month, in process of cure decreased 26.90% from last year and 51.39% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks show a total of 1,276,960 pounds of which 577,007 pounds are frozen and 399,953 pounds not frozen. Comparative figures show an decrease in total quantities of 41.73% from last year and an increase of 56.18% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 111,289 pounds, chickens 102,324 pounds, fowl 116,387 pounds, ducks 41,566 pounds, geese 65,660 pounds, turkeys 115,161 pounds, unclassified 143,195 pounds. The total of 695,602 pounds is a decrease of 1.63% from last year and a decrease of 2.01% from last month.

Fish stocks show 19,002,961 pounds, which is .15% less than stocks of last October and 5.37% more than last month.

Milk stocks show 2,049,106 pounds of condensed milk 5,629,147 pounds of evaporated milk, 263,396 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,167,305 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 3.76% in condensed milk; .97% decrease in evaporated milk; 4.36% increase in whole milk powder and .61% increase in skim milk powder.

Apples stocks are increasing, there being 6,222 barrels and 12,626 boxes reported in storage.
