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Cold Storage Holdings - November 1, 1922.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 24,155,215 pounds of creamery and 340,171 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 15.91% in the case of creamery and a decrease of 53.27% in dairy from the amount held in storage for corresponding date last year. Comparisons with 1st month show a decrease of 2.32% in creamery and 17.88% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 252,727 pounds, an increase of 22.28% from last November and 87.34% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 9,729,083 pounds, a decrease of 56.86% from last year and 47.55% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 10,011,630 dozen; other than cold storage 404,792 dozen and frozen 987,502 pounds.

Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 38.94% from last year and a decrease of 33.95% from last month; other than cold storage eggs decreased 19.75% from last year and increased 10.29% from last month; frozen eggs decreased 28.55% from last year and 33.03% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: - fresh frozen 2,062,923 pounds, not frozen 2,490,621 pounds, dry salted 1,549,127 pounds, sweet pickled 3,231,245 pounds, in process of cure 9,842,933 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen pork to have decreased 7.49% from corresponding date last year and 10.91% from same time last month; not frozen pork shows an increase of 21.13% from last year and 26.47% over last month; dry salted stocks show an increase of 23.70% over last year and a decrease of 18.28% from last month, sweet pickled stocks have decreased 29.42% from last year's holdings and 48.76% from last months; pork in process of cure shows an increase of 31.38% from last year and 30.75% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,690,052 pounds, an increase of 42.33% over last November's holdings and 1.79% over last month's stocks.

Beef stocks amount to 15,159,984 pounds of fresh frozen, 6,504,043 pounds of not frozen, 144,557 pounds of cured beef and 133,212 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have increased 68.71% over last November's holdings and 49.58% over last month; not frozen beef increased 43.04% over last year and 29.53% over last month; cured beef decreased 39.28% from last year and 35.69% from last month; in process of cure decreased 87.56% from last year and increased 3.28% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks show a total of 4,465,796 pounds, a decrease of 12.93% from last year and an increase of 249.62% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: - broilers 174,771 pounds, chickens 408,085 pounds, fowl 236,553 pounds, ducks 53,183 pounds, geese 66,683 pounds, turkeys 97,465 pounds, unclassified 285,966 pounds. The total of 1,222,706 pounds is a decrease of 15.62% from last year and an increase of 55.43% from last month.

Fish stocks show 18,079,875 pounds in cold storage, a decrease of 11.30% from last year and an increase of 3.26% from last month, other than cold storage stocks show 2,745,752 pounds a decrease of 20% from last year and an increase of 97.98% from last month.

Milk stocks show 1,301,166 pounds of condensed milk, a decrease of 36.51% from last month; evaporated milk 4,290,028 pounds, a decrease of 16.46%; whole milk powder 297,166 pounds, an increase of 12.82% over last month and 931,165 pounds of skim milk powder, a decrease of 36.55% from last month.

There are 46,838 barrels and 105,413 boxes of apples in storage.
