COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - February 1, 1922.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 8,954,277 pounds of creamery and 330,659 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 18.70% in the case of creamery and 12.56% in case of dairy from the amount held in storage on the first of January. Comparisons with corresponding month last year show an increase of 9.49% in creamery and 53.48% in case of dairy.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 210,692 pounds an increase of 4.75% over last month but a decrease of 53.70% from last year.

Cheese in storage amounts to 10,199,040 pounds being a decrease of 32.10% from last month and an increase of 111.59% from February first of last year.

Eggs in cold storage total 302,914 dozen a decrease of 69.37% from January 1st and an increase of 6.51% from last year; eggs other than cold storage show 185,641 dozen, a decrease of 23.39% from last month and 26.34% from corresponding period last year; frozen eggs total 985,428 pounds a decrease of 11.47% from preceding first of month and an increase of 7.12% from last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- 8,335,833 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,061,637 pounds of fresh not frozen, 1,879,224 pounds of cured dry salted; 4,451,736 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show an increase of fresh frozen stocks of 42.64% from last month and decrease of 2.36% from last year, fresh unfrozen stocks increased 21.63% from last month and decreased 28.57% from last year, dry salted stocks decreased 3.92% from last month and increased 4.36% from last year, sweet pickled stocks decreased 1.97% from last month and 40.99% from last year, stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 28% from January 1st. and an increase of 18.47% from February 1921.

Lard stocks in storage total 1,810,920 pounds; a decrease of 79% from last month and 18.82% from last year.

Beef stocks amount to 22,890,021 pounds of which 18,296,700 pounds are fresh frozen, 4,140,078 pounds fresh unfrozen, 298,022 pounds of cured and 155,221 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease in frozen stocks of 15.74% from last month and 9.72% from last year, fresh unfrozen increased 8.23% from last month and decreased 9.72% from last year, cured beef increased 21.45% from last first of month and 56.65% from corresponding period last year; in process of cure decreased 4.41% from first of January and 86% from last year.


Mutton and Lamb Stocks show 4,797,339 pounds of frozen and 287,492 pounds of unfrozen. Comparative figures show a decrease in frozen stocks of 23.30% from last month and 42.68% from last year, unfrozen stocks decreased 35.92% from last month and increased 27.17% from last February 1st.

Poultry stocks total 5,331,485 pounds of which 409,313 pounds are broilers, 2,125,964 pounds of chickens, 944,595 pounds of fowl, 238,258 pounds of ducks, 121,646 pounds of geese, 522,748 pounds of turkeys and 1,088,961 pounds of unclassified. Poultry stocks show a decrease of 1.84% from last month and an increase of 27.85% from last year.

Fish stocks amount to 15,583,151 pounds a decrease of 17.12% from January and 6.79% from last year at same period.


Stocks of milk show 3,703,673 pounds of condensed, 2,778,540 pounds of evaporated, 57,137 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,864,829 pounds of skim milk powder.

There are 18,786 barrels and 79,396 boxes of apples in storage.




