COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - March 1, 1922.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 5,852,306 pounds of creamery and 254,883 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 34.50% in the case of creamery and 22.6% in case of dairy from the amount held in storage on February 1st. Comparison with corresponding month last year show an increase of 3.19% in creamery butter and a decrease of 56.78% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 341,235 pounds, an increase of 78.85% from last month and 2.35% from last year.

Cheese in storage amounts to 6,761,636 pounds being a decrease of 35.86% from last month and an increase of 180.79% from last year.

Eggs in cold storage total 62,118 dozen a decrease of 74.99% from last month and 15.11% from last year, eggs other than cold storage show 208,140 dozen, an increase of 7.41% from February and 14.06% from last March; frozen eggs total 810,104 pounds, a decrease of 17.86% from last month and an increase of 11.12% from last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- 7,879,545 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,291,367 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 1,684,932 pounds of cured dry salted, 9,507,143 pounds of cured sweet pickled and 6,488,606 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease in frozen stocks of 5.17% from last month and 29.12% from last year, fresh unfrozen stocks increased 7.05% from the preceding month and decreased 12.01% from last year at the same time; dry salted pork decreased 10.63 from February and 3.61% from last year; sweet pickled shows an increase of 113.15% over last month and a decrease of 25.83% from last year, in process of cure decreased 35.84% from last first of the month and 25.44% for corresponding period last year.

Lard stocks show a total of 1,566,007 pounds, a decrease of 4,80% from last month and 42.15% from last year.

Beef stocks amount to 14,860,665 pounds of fresh frozen, 4,536,025 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 275,717 pounds of cured and 168,204 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease of 18.87% from last month and 20.33% from last year, in frozen stocks; unfrozen beef stocks increased 9.41% from last month and 4.03% from last year; cured beef decreased by 6.87% from last month and 61.27% from last year; in process of cure shows an increase of 5.65% from last month and a decrease of 10.09% from last year.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 3,951,906 pounds of which 3,857,105 pounds are frozen. Comparisons with last months holdings show a decrease of 17.61% in frozen stocks and 50.65% in unfrozen while compared with March 1st. of last year frozen stocks decreased 46.93% and unfrozen stocks increased 22.23%.

Stocks of poultry show 281,324 pounds of broilers, 2,296,542 pounds of chickens, 695,680 pounds of fowl, 106,784 pounds of ducks, 162,359 pounds of geese, 492,226 pounds of turkeys and 812,151 pounds of unclassified poultry. Comparative figures show a decrease in total stocks of 8.58% from last month and an increase of 41.22% from last year.

Fish in cold storage shows 12,787,473 pounds; a decrease of 12.85% from last month and 13.66% from last year; fish, other than cold storage increased 87.46% from amount held in storage first of last month, and decreased from last year at same period by 57.3%.

Apples in storage show a decrease of 65.32% from last month in number of barrels and 22.77% in number of boxes.

Holdings of condensed milk have decreased 44.82%, evaporated milk decreased 6.19%, whole milk powder decreased by 5.30% while skim milk powder increased by 5.91%. These comparisons are with holdings on February 1st. as no comparative figures are available for last year.
