

Cold Storage Holdings - April 1, 1922.

## General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 2,226,157 pounds of creamery and 193,894 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 7.10% in the case of creamery and 57.41% in the case of dairy from the amounts held in storage for the corresponding month last year. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 61.84% in creamery butter and 23.93% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 164,285 pounds a decrease of 46.20% from last year and 51.33% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 4,330,400 pounds, an increase of 278.78% from last April and a decrease of 35.41% from March 1st.

Eggs in cold storage total 444,395 dozen, other than cold stored 457,609 dozen and frozen eggs 823,235 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 11.95% from last year and an increase of 615.40% from last month; other than cold storage eggs decreased 9.91% from last year and increased 129.13% from last month; frozen eggs increased 34.76% from last year and 1.62% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows 9,150,245 pounds of fresh frozen, 1,982,927 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 1,720,520 pounds of dry salted, and 6,462,088 pounds of sweet pickled, 10,587,719 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease of 35.34% from last year in frozen pork and an increase of 16.33% from last month, not frozen increased 6.12% from last year and decreased 9.70% from last month; dry salted decreased 2.89% from last year and increased 2.55% from last month; Sweet pickled decreased 42.42% from last year and 32.03% from last month; in process of cure increased 9.30% from last April and 68.34% from March 1st.

Lard stocks show 2,416,335 pounds a decrease of 3.28% from amount held in storage on the corresponding date last year and an increase of 41.27% from the first of last month.

Beef stocks amount to 15,172,582 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,629,510 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 246,706 pounds of cured and 161,36 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- frozen beef has decreased 11.56% from last year and increased 2.25% from last month; unfrozen beef decreased 18.04% from last year and +1.77% from last month, cured stocks decreased 70.69% from last year and 10.47% from the previous month, in process of cure increased 29.32% from last year and decreased .79% from last month.

Stocks of mutton and lamb are 2,717,114 pounds of which 2,641,337 pounds are frozen and 75,777 pounds unfrozen. Comparative figures show a decrease in frozen stocks of 59.30% from last year and 31.35% from last month; unfrozen stocks increased 80.49% from last year and decreased 20.07 from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 218,172 pounds, chickens 1,346,131 pounds, fowl 600,999 pounds, ducks 90,701 pounds, geese 124,769 pounds, turkeys 396,953 pounds and unclassified 684,418 pounds. The total of 3,462,143 pounds is an increase of 32.64% from last year and a decrease of 27.75% from last month.

Fish stocks show 12,814,003 pounds of which 10,469,637 pounds are in cold storage. Cold storage stocks have decreased 18% from last month and 22.49% from last year.

Milk stocks show 1,870,427 pounds of condensed milk, 2,902,948 pounds of evaporated milk, 73,296 pounds of whole milk powder, 1,760,997 pounds of skim milk powder. Condensed milk stocks decreased 15.24% from amount held in storage first of March, evaporated milk increased 11.36%, whole milk powder increased 35.44% and skim milk powder decreased 9.83%.

Apples in storage show 9,540 barrels, an increase of 46.40% from last month and 27,238 boxes, a decrease of 55.59% from last month.
