Cold Storage Holdings - May 1, 1922.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 1,008,046 pounds of creamery and 113,414 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 13.92% in the case of creamery and 60.28% in case of dairy from corresponding month last year. Comparisons will last month show a decrease of 55.74% in creamery and 24.84% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 112,183 pounds a decrease of 59.98% from last year and 32.07% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 3,874,366 pounds an increase of 235.19% from last May 1st. and a decrease of 11.48% from April.

Eggs in cold storage total 4,099,323 dozen, other than cold storage 754,443 dozen, frozen 659,482 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage stocks of 19.78% from last year at same period and 821.34% from the first of last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 12.08% from last May and an increase of 51.08% from last month; frozen eggs increased 19.34% over same period last year and decreased 19.89% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows, 9,311,004 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,372,904 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 1,807,827 pounds of cured dry salted, 5,791,933 pounds of cured sweet pickled and 10,268,636 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show a decrease of 27.14% in frozen pork from last year and an increase of 12.99% from last month; unfrozen pork decreased 13.68% from last year and increased 15.58% from last month; dry salted pork increased 3.95% from last year and 5.34% from last month; sweet pickled decreased 30.71% from last year and 9.64% from last month, in process of cure has decreased 6.97% over amount held in storage at the same period last year and 3.64% from the first of last month.

Lard stocks show 2,755,346 pounds a decrease of 1.19% from last year and an increase of 9.7% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 8,555,634 pounds of fresh frozen, 3,072,232 pounds of fresh unfrozen, 235,724 pounds of cured and 199,465 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following - frozen beef has decreased 28.69% from last year and 42.19% from last month, not frozen beef increased 22.61% from last year and 18.85% from last month; cured beef decreased 50.38% from last year and 7.09% from last month, beef in process of cure increased 29.15% over first of May last year and 26.88% over first of last month.

Stocks of mutton and lamb are 1,378,583 pounds of frozen and 44,168 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show a decrease in frozen stocks of 70.36% from last year and 47.09% from last month, not frozen stocks decreased 39.82% from last year and 41.79% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 168,441 pounds, chickens 1,018,781 pounds, fowl 469,815 pounds, ducks 76,863 pounds, geese 114,829 pounds, turkeys 361,355 pounds, unclassified 471,841 pounds. The total of 2,681,925 pounds is 34.03% more than that held in storage on first of May last year and 24.05% less than the amount in storage last month.

Fish stocks show 10,978,641 pounds of which 9,372,530 pounds are in cold storage and 1,606,111 pounds other than cold storage. Cold storage stocks decreased 33.24% from last year and 13.39% from last month, other than cold storage stocks increased 1.26% from last year and decreased 40.26% from last month.

Milk stocks show 1,504,864 pounds of condensed milk, 3,015,794 pounds of evaporated milk, 52,918 pounds of whole milk powder, 1,704,067 pounds of skim milk powder. Condensed milk stocks decreased 19.55% from the amount held in storage last month, evaporated milk stocks increased 3.88% from last month, whole milk powder decreased 27.81% and skim milk powder decreased 4.32%.

Apples in storage show 2,397 barrels, a decrease of 74.85% from last month and 27,349 boxes a decrease of 19.41% from last month.
