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COLD STORAGE REPORT

JUNE 1, 1922

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - June 1, 1922.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 2,802,073 pounds of creamery and 107,622 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 1.33% in each case of creamery and 64.06% for dairy as compared with the corresponding month of last year. Comparisons with last month show an increase of 180.80% in creamery butter and a decrease of 4.72% for dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 121,739 pounds a decrease of 53.25% from last year and an increase of 12.62% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 5,907,979 pounds an increase of 112.27% from last June and 53.63% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 10,586,316 dozen; other than cold storage 871,726 dozen, frozen eggs 786,479 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 17.76% from last year and 161.46% from last month, other than cold storage eggs increased 8.66% over last year and 17.38% from last month; frozen eggs increased 27.81% from last year and 19.35% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: - fresh frozen, 8,302,868 pounds; fresh not frozen, 2,245,457 pounds, cured dry salted 1,503,805 pounds, cured sweet pickled 6,444,964 pounds, in process of cure 9,993,786 pounds. Comparative figures show the following: - frozen pork has decreased 34.02% from last year and 9.05% from last month; not frozen increased .64% from last year and decreased 3.06% from last month; dry salted decreased 25.41% from last year and 16.65% from last month; sweet pickled decreased 34.05% from last June and increased 11.04% from last month; in process of cure decreased 28.01% from last year and 3.52 percent from previous month.

Lard stocks show 2,571,135 pounds a decrease of 17.10% from last year and 6.21% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 9,801,885 pounds of fresh frozen, 1,301,007 pounds of fresh not frozen, 197,890 pounds of cured and 24,882 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following: Frozen beef decreased 13.50% from last year at the same date and increased 14.78% from first of May, not frozen beef increased 14.45% from last June and 6.9% from last month; cured beef decreased 38.09% from last year and 16.15% from last month; in process pf cure increased 59.41% from last year and 3.24% from last month.

Stocks of Mutton and Lamb are 757,694 pounds of frozen and 14,088 pounds not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 74.98% from last year and 44.61% from last month; not frozen stocks decreased 35.50% from previous year and increased 113.31% from last month.

Stocks of poultry follow: - broilers 131,143 pounds, chickens 673,205 pounds, fowl 358,295 pounds, ducks 76,327 pounds, geese 111,442 pounds, turkeys 329,151 pounds, unclassified 348,638 pounds. The total of 2,028,201 pounds is an increase over last year of 53.15% but shows a decrease from last month of 24.79%.

Fish stocks show 8,571,068 pounds in cold storage and 820,991 pounds other than cold storage. The total of 9,392,059 pounds is a decrease of 46.04% from last year's holdings and 15.47% from last month.

Milk stocks show 1,284,640 pounds of condensed milk, 1,172,252 pounds of evaporated milk, 25,122 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,439,588 pounds of skim milk powder. Condensed milk stocks decreased 14.64% from last month; evaporated milk stocks increased 38.34% whole milk powder stocks decreased 52.53% and skim milk powder stocks decreased 15.53%.

Apples in storage show 1,102 barrels and 11,248 boxes a decrease of 54.03% in number of barrels and 59.32% in number of boxes.
