COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - JULY 1, 1922.

GENERAL SUMMARY.

The butter in storage amounts to 10,178,891 pounds of creamery and 426,671 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of .34% in the case of creamery and 18.83% in the case of dairy from the amounts held in storage for corresponding dates last year. Comparisons with last month show an increase of 260.20% in creamery butter and 281.45% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks show 237,876 pounds; an increase of 39.07% from last year and 96.41% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 9,371,980 pounds, an increase of 98.53% over corresponding date last year and 59.40% from the first of June.

Eggs in cold storage total 14,879,228 dozen; other than cold storage 790,211 dozen, frozen eggs 885,357 pounds. Comparative figures show stocks of cold storage eggs to have increased 55.88% from last year and 40.42% from last month; other than cold storage eggs decreased 5.59% from last year's holdings and increased to 6.20% from last month; frozen eggs increased 13.97% from last year and 12.28% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 7,663,542 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,073,583 pounds; dry salted 1,775,874 pounds; sweet pickled 6,591,870 pounds and in process of cure 10,421,230 pounds. Comparative figures for fresh frozen pork show a decrease of 25.63% from last year and 5.28% from last month; unfrozen pork increased 2.08% over last year's stocks and decreased 8.26% from last month; dry salted increased 37.28% from last year and 26.94% from last month; sweet pickled increased 5.28% from last year and 14.11% from last month in process of cure decreased 4.50% from last year and increased 1.81% from last month.

Lard stocks show 2,714,940 pounds, an increase of 23.34% from corresponding date last year and 5.37% from last month.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,845,537 pounds, not frozen 2,964,902 pounds, cured 193,394 pounds, in process of cure 192,183 pounds. Comparative figures show frozen beef to have decreased 16.16% from last year and 31.56% from last month; not frozen beef decreased .14% from last year and 6.28% from last month; cured beef decreased 47.07% from last July's stocks and 2.61% from last month; in process of cure there is a decrease of 35.10% from last year and 7.47% from last month.

The stocks of mutton and lamb show 488,209 pounds of frozen which is a decrease of 75.50% from last year and 36.05% from last month not frozen stocks show 110,924 pounds, an increase of 144.41% from last year and 18.08% from last month.

Poultry stocks follow:- Broilers 89,972 pounds, chickens 434,020 pounds, fowl 254,574 pounds, ducks 58,236 pounds, geese 108,191 pounds, turkeys 281,349 pounds, unclassified 171,107 pounds. The total of 1,397,449 pounds shows an increase of 5.78% from last year and a decrease of 30.10% from last month.

Fish in cold storage amounts to 13,424,962 pounds, a decrease of 27.32% from last July and an increase of 37.19% from June 1st. Other than cold storage fish amounts to 814,542 pounds a decrease of 49.91% from last year and .71% from last month.

Apple stocks in cold storage are practically nil showing only 25 barrels and 2,086 boxes.

Stocks of milk show 1,264,386 pounds of condensed milk, being an increase of 6.13% from the previous month; 5,351,482 pounds of evaporated milk, an increase of 30.52%; 131,530 pounds of whole milk powder being an increase of 423.96%; 1,768,858 pounds of skim milk powder which is an increase of 22.08% over stocks on hand the first of June.
