COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - SEPTEMBER 1, 1922.

GENERAL SUMMARY.

The butter in storage amounts to 23,615,426 pounds of creamery and 344,056 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this in the case of creamery to be an increase of 14.89% from last year and 28.37% from last month. ^{x 31}

Oleomargarine stocks are now 113,567 pounds a decrease of 62.42% from corresponding period of last year and 7.06% from first of August.

Cheese in storage amounts to 21,169,148 pounds an increase of 2.03% from last year and 26.28% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 16,393,376 dozen, other than cold storage 372,971 dozen, frozen 1,329,786 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 16.51% from last September and a decrease of 2.36% from last month; other than cold storage eggs decreased 35.36% from last year at same period and 27.74% from last month; Frozen eggs increased 99.91% from last year and 39.22% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows - fresh frozen 4,001,026 pounds, fresh not frozen 2,292,446 pounds, cured dry salted 1,904,180 pounds, cured sweet pickled 6,194,866 pounds, in process of cure 9,930,143 pounds Comparative figures show an increase in frozen stocks of 4.36% from last year and a decrease of 42.22% from last month, not frozen stocks increased 67.80% from last year and decreased 8.20% from last month; dry salted stocks increased 27.92% over last year and 15.45% over last month holdings, sweet pickled pork shows a decrease of 18.45% from last year's stocks and an increase of 10.40% from last month, pork in process of cure show an increase of 44.74% from last year and a decrease of 15.98% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,672,035 pounds, a decrease of 16.32% from last year and 41.66% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 6,677,700 pounds of fresh frozen, 3,510,531 pounds of fresh not frozen, 138,524 pounds of cured and 265,542 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show an increase in frozen stocks of .65% from last year and 17.09% from last month, not frozen stocks decreased 4.75% from last year and increased 14.75% from last month, cured beef shows a decrease of 59.25% from last year and an increase of 41.12% from last month; beef in process of cure shows an increase of 8.27% from last year and 46.06% from last month.

Mutton & Lamb stocks are 425,620 pounds of frozen and 356,537 pounds not frozen. Comparative figures show a decrease of 45.82% from last year and an increase of 33.53% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 80,393 pounds, chickens 83,072 pounds, fowl 110,933 pounds, ducks 46,880 pounds, geese 83,495 pounds, turkeys 176,633 pounds, unclassified 126,245 pounds. The total of 715,651 pounds shows an increase of 24.77% over amount held in storage last year and a decrease of 32.52% from last first of month's holding.

Fish stocks show 18,454,629 pounds, a decrease of 11.88% from last year and an increase of 15.74% from last month.

There are 2,129,159 pounds of condensed milk in stock, an increase of 67.12%, 5,684,016 pounds of evaporated milk, an increase of 1.17% over last month; 252,385 pounds of whole milk powder being an increase of 44.02% over last month and 1,450,090 pounds of skim milk powder showing a decrease of 10.26% from last month.

Apples stocks show 1,650 barrels and 2,571 boxes.
