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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS DECEMBER 1, 1923.

General Summary

Published December 20, 1923.

The butter in storage amounts to 19,841,253 pounds of creamery and 513,085 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 2.69% in case of creamery and 140.74% for dairy over the corresponding month last year. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 27.26% in creamery and 3.61% in dairy.

Creamerine stocks are now 726,948 pounds, an increase of 249.27% over last years holdings and a decrease of 31.98% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 14,342,298 pounds, showing an increase of 80.24% over last year and a decrease of 14.77% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage show a total of 4,827,133 dozen, other than cold storage 239,897 dozen and frozen 1,128,797 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage eggs to have decreased 10.39% from last year and 48.01% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 36.07% from last year and 19.46% from last month; frozen eggs show an increase of 23.18% over last December holdings and a decrease of 17.03% from November.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 3,309,142 pounds; fresh not frozen 4,261,649 pounds; cured dry salted 1,846,603 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,138,744 pounds; in process of cure 8,561,670 pounds. Comparative figures show frozen pork stocks to have increased 30.75% from last year and increased 60.80% over last month; not frozen pork shows an increase of 23.60% over last December and 40.36% over the previous month; dry salted shows a decrease of 35.12% from last year's stocks and an increase of 10.36% from last month; sweet pickled shows a decrease of 6.97% from last year and an increase of 116.27% over November holdings; pork in process of cure shows an increase of 11.18% over last year and 9.38% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,220,596 pounds, being an increase of 8.89% over last December's holdings and 43.04% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 16,655,818 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,949,538 pounds of fresh not frozen; 205,491 pounds of cured, and 94,820 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen beef to have decreased 23.28% from last year and increased 50.17% from last month; not frozen beef shows a decrease of 4.22% from last year and an increase of 13.04% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 28.08% over last year and a decrease of 12.84% from last month; beef in process of cure has decreased 55.04% from last years stocks and decreased 18.16% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 4,594,680 pounds of which 4,224,035 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 29.07% from last year and an increase of 78.01% from last month; not frozen stocks show an increase of 23.37% over last December's stocks and a decrease of 33.41% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 208,504 pounds; chickens 860,381 pounds; fowl 456,033 pounds; ducks 84,500 pounds; geese 75,246 pounds; turkeys 199,983 pounds; unclassified 525,399 pounds. The total of 2,410,046 pounds shows a decrease of 12.28% from last years holdings and an increase of 105.63% over last month.

Fish stocks show 17,552,508 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,979,212 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish stocks show an increase of 2.85% over last month and other in cold storage show an increase of 17.25% over November.

There are 2,508,221 pounds of condensed milk in storage; 4,696,777 pounds of evaporated milk; 31,249 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,196,072 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have increased 129.09% over last year and decreased 26.68% from last month; evaporated milk shows an increase of 57.87% over last year and a decrease of 29.60% from last month; whole milk powder shows a decrease of 35.71% from last year and 67.47% from last month; skim milk powder shows an increase of 97.98% over last year and 12.65% over last month.

Apple stocks show 71,842 barrels and 221,800 boxes. Comparative figures show barrelled apples to have decreased 17.29% from last year and increased 64.55% from last month. Boxed apples have increased 24.04% over last year and 115.76% over last month.
