Cold Storage Holdings, - February 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 10,412.239 pounds of creamery and 119.984 pounds of Dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 15.51% in the case of creamery and a decrease of 63.61% in the case of Dairy from the amount held in storage for the corresponding month last year. Comparison with last month show creamery stocks to have decreased 2%.18% and dairy shows a decrease of 2.92%.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 197.785 pounds a decrease of 6.45% from February 1st last year and 1.15% increase from first of last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 2,822.071 pounds; a decrease of 73.21% from February 1st of last year and a decrease of 45.50% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 499.228 dozen, other than cold storage 226.697 dozen and frozen 359.849 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks of eggs to have increased 64.91% and decreased 79.15% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 17.77% over last year and decrease of 41.41% over last month; frozen eggs show a decrease of 43.19% from last year and 13.22% from last month,

Pork stocks are as follows 12,673.522 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,806.067 fresh not frozen; 2,424.178 pounds of dry salted; 8,399.691 pounds of sweet pickled; and 8,925.542 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen pork to have increased 52.02% from last year and increased 59.18% from last month, not frozen pork increase of 28.25% over last year and increased 9.53% over last month. Dry salted increase of 28.57% over last year and increased 20.02% over last month, sweet pickled increased 82.32% over last year; and increased 2.63% over last month; In process of cure decreased 15.98% from last year and increased 16.13% over last month,

Lard in storage total 2,297.179 pounds, an increase of 24.46% from last year and decreased 5.75% from last month.

Beef stock in storage total 16,687.203 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,658.906 pounds of fresh unfrozen; 4,77.311 pounds of cured and 196.469 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have decreased 9.67% from last year and a decrease of 17.20% from last month. Not frozen beef shows an increase 35.83% over last year and an increase of 16.67% over last month; Cured beef shows an increase of 36.59% over last year and decrease of 69.87% from last month. In process of cure shows an increase of 23.84% over last year and decrease of 16.61% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 5,733.176 pounds of frozen and 201.385 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have increased 18.69% over last year and decreased 2.13% from last month; not frozen stocks show an increase of 4.84% over last year and a decrease of 11.56% from last month.

Poultry stocks are as follows:- 171.662 pounds of broilers; 2,033.636 pounds of chickens; 788.987 pounds of fowl; 142.440 pounds of ducks 130.134 pounds of geese; 679.342 pounds of turkeys; and 1,723.785 pounds. An increase of 7.34% over last year and a decrease of 3.86% from last month. Fresh frozen stocks of fish show 11,644.730 pounds a decrease of 19.97% from last month.

Milk stocks show 937.993 pounds of condensed milk, 2,359.722 pounds of evaporated milk; 151.879 pounds of whole milk powder, and 296.718 pounds skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have decreased 74.67% from last year and 11.76% from last month; evaporated milk stocks show a decrease of 15.07% from last year and 16.35% from last month; whole milk powder stocks show an increase of 165.82% over last year and 646.65% over last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 84.09% from last year and 24.24% from last month.

Apples in storage show 59,865 barrels and 122,841 boxes. Comparative figures show an increase of 213.67% in number of barrels over amount held in storage last year and 17.46% decrease from last month; In the number of boxes there is an increase shown of 54.72% over last year and a decrease of 28.25% from last month.
