Cold Storage Holdings - March 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 5,540,241 pounds of creamery and 210,946 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 43.95% in the case of creamery and an increase of 66.56% in dairy from the amount held in storage on February 1st. Comparisons with last year show creamery butter to have decreased 5.34% and dairy butter 17.34%.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 116,258 pounds, a decrease of 4.28% from last month and 35.94% from last year.

Cheese stocks show 1,935,962 pounds, a decrease of 71.36% from last year and 31.36% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage show 70,992 dozen, other than cold storage 148,847 dozen and frozen 368,252 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 14.25% over last year and decreased 86.22% from last month; other than cold storage stocks decreased 28.49% from last year and 34.57% from last month; frozen egg stocks show a decrease of 54.55% from last year and 34.59% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: 12,317,157 pounds of fresh frozen, 3,329,482 pounds of unfrozen, 2,056,757 pounds of dry salted, 9,259,311 pounds of sweet pickled and 7,536,251 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following: fresh frozen pork an increase of 56.31% over last year and 9.72% over last month; not frozen pork shows an increase of 4.53% over last year and 22.85% over last month; dry salted shows an increase of 22.09% over last year and a decrease of 9.87% from last month; sweet pickled shows a decrease of 2.61% from last year and an increase of 10.44% from last month; in process of cure shows an increase of 16.14% over last year and 8.66% over last month.

Lard stocks show 2,158,203 pounds, an increase of 3.78% over last year and a decrease of 1.53% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 11,847,781 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,924,339 pounds of unfrozen, 362,504 pounds of cured and 178,797 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show stocks of frozen beef to have decreased 20.33% from last year and 21.51% from last month; not frozen beef stocks show an increase of 8.56% from last year and a decrease of 11.42% from last month; cured beef stocks show an increase of 31.47% from last year and a decrease of 9.81% from last month; in process of cure shows an increase of 6.29% from last year and a decrease of 9% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 4,860,043 pounds of frozen and 188,646 pounds of unfrozen. Comparative figures show an increase in the total of 27.75% over last year and a decrease of 12.71% from last month.

Stocks of poultry show 188,122 pounds of broilers, 1,916,514 pounds of chickens, 685,935 pounds of fowl, 135,233 pounds of ducks, 132,651 pounds of geese, 809,066 pounds of turkeys and 1,170,196 pounds of unclassified. The total of 5,037,697 pounds is an increase of 4.58% over last year and a decrease of 10.55% from last month.

Fish stocks show 7,556,460 pounds, a decrease of 16.34% from last month.

Milk stocks show 691,693 pounds of condensed, 2,380,486 pounds of evaporated, 35,818 pounds of whole milk powder and 310,868 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have decreased 72.36% from last year and 26.26% from last month; evaporated milk stocks have decreased 6.66% from last year and increased .87% from last month; whole milk powder shows a decrease of 33.82% from last year and an increase of 33.25% from last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 84.25% from last year and an increase of 10.34% from last month.

Apples in storage show 40,605 barrels, an increase of 523.15% from last year and a decrease of 31.68% from last month; 72,541 boxes which is an increase of 18.46% over last March and a decrease of 40.95% from last month.
