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COLD STORAGE REPORT

APRIL 1, 1923

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Cold Storage Holdings - March 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 3,129,153 pounds of creamery and 35,303 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 40.56% in the case of creamery and 9.16% in dairy from the amounts held in storage for corresponding date last year. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 45.51% in creamery and 23.54% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 130,189 pounds, an increase of 9.16 from last year and an increase of 51.67% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 1,365,946 pounds a decrease of 68.46% from last year and 31.24% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 255,841 dozen, other than cold storage 307,229 dozen and frozen 239,887 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 12.01% from last year and an increase of 91.51% from last month; other than cold storage stocks show a decrease of 34.40% from last year and an increase of 93.52% from last month while frozen eggs have decreased 70.87% from last year and 34.88% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: - 15,721,145 pounds of fresh frozen; 1,754,255 pounds of cured dry salted; 7,653,337 pounds of cured sweet pickled and 9,325,614 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show an increase in fresh frozen pork of 71.81% over last year and 9.67% over last month; fresh not frozen shows an increase of 85.20% over last year and 1.53% over last month; dry salted shows an increase of 1.96% over last year and a decrease of 14.87% from last month; sweet pickled has increased 17.12% over amount held in storage last year and decreased 24.11% from last month; in process of cure shows a decrease of 11.93% from last April and an increase of 9.99% from last month.

Lard stocks show 2,213,643 pounds, a decrease of 8.39% from last year and 15.14% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 10,340,329 pounds of fresh frozen, 3,891,928 pounds of fresh not frozen, 417,223 pounds of cured and 272,220 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 31.25% from amount held in storage for corresponding date last year and 23.44% from amount held last month; not frozen stocks show an increase of 48.01% over last year and a decrease of 22.87% from last month; cured beef stocks have increased 69.11% over last year and 14.05% over last month; in process of cure shows an increase of 68.69% over last year and 52.16% over last month.

Stocks of mutton and lamb show 3,862,877 pounds of frozen and 120,664 pounds of not frozen. The total of 3,983,541 pounds shows an increase of 46.64% over last year and a decrease of 27.56% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: - broilers 193,028 pounds, chickens 1,591,257 pounds, fowl 689,617 pounds, ducks 163,324 pounds, geese 153,526 pounds, turkeys 945,907 pounds, unclassified 923,172 pounds. The total of 4,659,825 pounds shows an increase of 34.59% over corresponding date last year, and a decrease of 9.17% from last month.

Fish stocks show 9,032,957 pounds of fresh frozen and 1,557,166 pounds of other in cold storage.

Milk stocks show 509,656 pounds of condensed milk, 2,459,547 pounds of evaporated milk, 157,958 pounds of whole milk powder and 388,814 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show a decrease in stocks of condensed milk of 52.76% from last year and 26.32% from last month; evaporated milk stocks show a decrease of 15.28% from last year and an increase of 3.32% from last month; whole milk powder shows an increase of 115.59% over last April's holdings and 341.69% over last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 78.17% from last year and an increase of 25.07% from last month.

Apples in storage show 20,388 barrels and 51,546 boxes. There is an increase in number of barrels of 113.71% over last year and a decrease of 49.79% from last month; number of boxes increased 50.24% over last April and decreased 23.93% from last month.
