Cold Storage Holdings, - May 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 2,080,351 pounds of creamery and 24,212 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 106.36% in the case of creamery and a decrease of 78.66% in dairy from the amounts held in storage for corresponding date last year. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 32.31% in creamery and 31.42% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 227,661 pounds, and increase of 102.93% from last year and 26.66% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 1,690,691 pounds, a decrease of 56.37% from last year at same date and an increase of 23.81% over the first of last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 1,831,537 dozen, other than cold storage 537,186 dozen and frozen 231,499 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 55.33% from last May and an increase of 420.36% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 18.80% from last year and an increase of 71.13% from last month; frozen eggs show a decrease of 64.90% from last year and 13.50% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 16,794,381 pounds, fresh not frozen 3,701,386 pounds, cured dry salted 2,055,053 pounds, cured sweet pickled 8,421,266 pounds, in process of cure 10,128,156 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase of 80.35% in fresh frozen from amount held in storage last May and of 7.15% over last month; fresh not frozen shows an increase of 55.98% from last year and 1.11% over last month; dry salted shows an increase of 13.67% from last year and 17.71% over last month; sweet pickled shows an increase of 45.39% over last year and 11.64% over last month; in process of cure shows a decrease of 1.37% from last May and an increase of 7.76% over last month.

Lard stocks show 2,700,871 pounds, a decrease of 1.98% from last year and an increase of 21.14% over last month.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 9,013,726 pounds fresh not frozen 3,678,966 pounds, cured 358,183 pounds, in process of cure 175,930 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have increased 5.35% from amount held in storage last May and decreased 10.71% from last month; fresh not frozen has increased 19.74% over last year and decreased 4.49% from last month; cured beef shows an increase of 51.95% over last year and a decrease of 13.57% from last month; but in process of cure shows a decrease of 11.80% from last May and 25.67% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks show 3,153,195 pounds of frozen and 67,016 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 128.68% over last year and a decrease of 18.16% from last month; not frozen stocks show an increase of 51.93% over last year and a decrease of 44.15% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 188,157 pounds, chickens 1,165,118 pounds, fowl 459,554 pounds, ducks 105,406 pounds, geese 57,197 pounds, turkeys 668,204 pounds, and unclassified 597,900 pounds. The total of 3,281,536 pounds shows an increase of 22.35% over last year and a decrease of 24% from last month.

Fish stocks show 7,945,428 pounds of fresh frozen, a decrease of 9.32% from last month and 1,358,853 pounds of other in cold storage.

Milk stocks show 1,282,226 pounds of condensed milk, 2,565,709 pounds of evaporated milk, 30,381 pounds of whole milk powder and 432,484 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have decreased 14.80% from last year, and increased 151.58% from last month, evaporated milk stocks show a decrease of 14.93% from last year and an increase of 4.31% from last month; whole milk powder has decreased 42.59% from stocks of last May and 80.77% from last month; skim milk powder has decreased 71.10% from last year and increased 26.66% over last month.

Apples in storage show 9,979 barrels and 34,748 boxes. There is an increase in number of barrels of 316.31% from last year's holdings as at May 1st but a decrease of 51.06% from last month. Apples in boxes show an increase of 25.67% from last May and a decrease of 32.59% from last month.
