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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, - June 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 3,375.436 pounds of creamery and 66.293 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 63.37% in the case of creamery and 176.16% in dairy from amount held in storage last month. Comparisons with last year show an increase of 20.42% in creamery butter and a decrease of 38.41% in dairy butter.

Olcotmargarine stocks are now 179.789 pounds a decrease of 20.84% from last month and an increase of 47.68% from last year.

Cheese stocks show 3,872.025 pounds, an increase of 129.87% over last month but a decrease of 34.47% from last year.

Eggs in cold storage show 9,864.143 dozen, other than cold storage 704.998 dozen and frozen 407.209 pounds; Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 439.31% from last month and decreased 6.83% from last year; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 33.32% over last month and a decrease of 19.13% from last year; frozen eggs have increased 75.90% over. May holdings and decreased 48.23% from last June.

Pork stocks are as follows:- 15,541.613 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,796.865 pounds of fresh not frozen, 2,237.147 pounds of dry salted, 8,590.654 pounds of sweet pickled and 10,090.789 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen pork shows a decrease of 8.08% from last month and an increase of 87.18% over last year; not frozen pork has decreased 23.35% from last month and increased 24.55% over last June's holdings; dry salted pork shows an increase of 7.03% over last month and 47.76% over last year; sweet pickled pork increased 2.53% over holdings as at first of May and 33.29% over last year; pork, in process of cure shows an increase of 1.23% over last month and .97% over last June.

Lard stocks show 3,074.143 pounds, an increase of 13.21% over last month and 19.56% over last year.

Beef stocks amount to 6,846.089 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,926.326 pounds of fresh not frozen; 319.297 pounds of cured, and 100.829 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show stocks of frozen beef to have decreased 24.88% from last month and 30.16% from last year; not frozen beef shows an increase of 6.52% over last month and 18.94% over last year; cured beef shows a decrease of 10.82% from last month and an increase of 61.35% over last year; in process of cure shows a decrease of 41% from last month and 50.69% from last year.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 1,908.994 pounds of frozen and 98.513 pounds of not frozen; Comparative figures show the total of 2,007.507 pounds to be a decrease of 38.03% from last month and an increase of 35.68% from last year.

Stocks of poultry show 75.108 pounds of broilers; 782.313 pounds of chickens, 325.114 pounds of fowl, 116.510 pounds of ducks, 123.156 pounds of geese, 803.789 pounds of turkeys and 488.693 pounds of unclassified. The total of 2,714.683 pounds is a decrease of 17.78% from last month and an increase of 38.84% from last year.

Fish stocks show 8,582.975 pounds of fresh frozen and 1,110.481 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 7.78% over last month, and other fish in cold storage shows a decrease of 18.27% from last month.

Milk stocks show 2,003.716 pounds of condensed milk, 5,075.782 pounds of evaporated milk, 121.308 pounds of whole milk powder and 433.417 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show an increase in condensed milk of 56.26% from last month and 55.97% from last year; evaporated milk stocks show an increase of 97.83% over last month and 21.65% over last year, whole milk powder shows an increase of 299.28% over last month and 382.87% over last year; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 12% from last month and 69.90% from last year.

There are 842 barrels of apples in storage, a decrease of 91.57% from last month and 23.60% from last year; and 13,107 boxes of apples showing a decrease of 62% from last month and an increase of 16.52% over last year.
