COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - July 1, 1923.

GENERAL SUMMARY.

The butter in storage amounts to 12,662,653 pounds of creamery and 232,763 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 15.40% in case of creamery and a decrease of 45.45% in case of dairy from the amounts held in storage for corresponding dates last year. Comparison with last month show an increase in creamery butter of 281.92% and 277.89% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks show 181,645 pounds, a decrease of 23.64% from last July's holdings and an increase of 9.44% from last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 11,837,682 pounds, being an increase of 26.30% over last year and 206.51% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage total 14,796,647 dozen, other than cold storage 783,203 dozen and frozen 693,630 pounds. Comparative figures show stocks of cold storage eggs to have decreased .56% as compared with last July and increased 51.97% compared with June; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of .89% from last year and an increase of 14.77% over last month; frozen eggs show a decrease of 21.66% from last year and an increase of 70.68% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 11,815,663 pounds, fresh not frozen 3,067,510 pounds cured dry salted 2,248,742 pounds cured sweet pickled 6,805,728 pounds and in process of cure 9,328,718 pounds. Comparative figures for fresh frozen pork show an increase of 67.27% over last July's holdings and a decrease of 23.49% from last month; fresh not frozen increased 47.93% over last year and 8.16% over last month, cured dry salted increased 26.62% over last year and 1.62% over last month; cured sweet pickled shows an increase of 3.24% over last July and a decrease of 20.93% from last month; pork in process of cure shows a decrease of 10.49% from last year and 7.90% from last month.

Lard stocks show 2,958,118 pounds, being an increase of 8.95% over last July stocks and 2.38% over last month.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,487,776 pounds, fresh not frozen 2,580,783 pounds, cured 277,901 pounds, and in process of cure 157,160 pounds. Comparative figures show frozen beef stocks to have decreased 34.45% from last year's holdings and 32.74% from last month; fresh not frozen beef shows a decrease of 12.96% from last year and 33% from last month; cured beef shows an increase of 43.69% over last year and a decrease of 13% from last month, beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 18.33% from last year and an increase of 51.35% from last month.

The stocks of mutton and lamb show 1,063,104 pounds of frozen and 85,702 pounds of not frozen. The total of 1,148,806 pounds is an increase of 91.74% over last year and a decrease of 41.77% from last month.

Poultry stocks follow:- Broilers 47,242 pounds, chickens 472,945 pounds, fowl 255,208 pounds, ducks 111,412 pounds; geese 107,460 pounds turkeys 702,846 pounds and unclassified 353,396 pounds. The total of 2,050,540 pounds is an increase of 46.73% over last year and a decrease of 23.57% from June holdings.

Fresh frozen fish amounts to 11,229,740 pounds, an increase of 29.97% from last month, fish other in cold storage shows 1,943,119 lbs. being an increase of 51.43% over last month.

There are 64 barrels and 1,392 boxes of apples shown in storage.

Stocks of milk show 2,512,853 pounds of condensed milk, 6,812,263 pounds of evaporated milk, 126,413 pounds of whole milk powder and 589,981 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show stocks of condensed milk to have increased 98.74% from last year and 25.40% from last month; evaporated milk stocks show an increase of 27.28% over last year and 34.21% over last month; whole milk powder shows a decrease of 3.90% from last year and an increase of 4.20% over last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 66.65% from last July and an increase of 36.12% from last month.
