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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, - August 1, 1923.

General Summary.

The butter in storage amounts to 25,278.328 pounds of creamery and 615.691 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 98.6% in the case of creamery and 143.27% in dairy from amount held in storage last month. Comparisons with last year show an increase of 39.07% in creamery butter and an increase of 12.15% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 505.454 pounds an increase of 133.02% over last month and an increase of 312.70% last year.

Cheese in cold storage show 16,849.850 pounds an increase of 41.98% over last month and an increase of .87% over last year.

Eggs in storage show 14,959.206 dozen, other than cold storage 1,299.926 dozen and frozen 745.032 pounds; comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 1.21% over last month and decreased 10.72% from last year; Other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 69.65% over last month and increased 176.46% over last year; frozen eggs have increased 3.15% over last month and decreased 21.97% from last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- 8,887.118 pounds fresh frozen; 2,471.803 pounds fresh not frozen; 3,341.168 pounds cured dry salted; 5,466.726 pounds cured sweet pickled; 9,047.930 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show the following:- fresh frozen pork decreased 25.02% from last month and increased 32.03% over last year; fresh not frozen decreased 14.06% from last month and increased 3.37% over last year; cured dry salted increased 67.03% over last month and increased 133.54% over last year; cured sweet pickled decreased 18.77% from last month and decreased .52% from last August's holdings; in process of cure decreased .94% from last month and decreased 16.31% from last year.

Lard stocks show 3,034.040 pounds, a decrease of 1.42% from last month and an increase of 11.39% over last year.

Beef stocks amount to 3,935.580 pounds fresh frozen, 3,038.602 pounds fresh not frozen, 301.802 pounds cured, and 132.931 in process of cure. Comparative figures show stocks of frozen beef to have decreased 15.29% from last month, and decreased 27.07% from last year; beef not frozen shows an increase of 17.84% over last month; and 18.06% over last year; cured beef shows an increase of 5.27% over last month and 221.93% over last August's holdings; in process of cure shows a decrease of 10.38% from last month and 27.70% from last year.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 606.802 pounds of frozen and 156.674 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show the total of 763.476 to be a decrease of 34.60% from last month and an increase of 56.20% from last year.

Stocks of poultry show:- 30.597 pounds of Broilers; 338.499 pounds of Chickens, 194.921 pounds of fowl; 79.150 pounds of ducks; 81.034 pounds of geese; 560.240 pounds of Turkeys and 282.132 pounds of unclassified. The total of 1,566.573 pounds is a decrease of 13.67% from last month and an increase of 59.39% from last year.

Fish stocks show 12,173.833 pounds of fresh frozen, 2,375.321 pounds of other in cold storage, fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 8.81% over last month and other in cold storage fish show an increase of 25.58% over last year.

Milk stocks show 3,289.041 pounds of condensed milk; 5,521.623 pounds of evaporated milk; 921.519 pounds of whole milk powder and 883.315 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show an increase of 35.35% over last month and 159.37% over last year; evaporated milk shows a decrease of 16.45% from last month and 1.72% from last year; whole milk powder shows an increase of 828.87% over last month and 259.98% over last year; Skim milk powder shows an increase of 49.71% over last month and 47.29% over last year.

Apples in cold storage amount to 84 barrels and 2,682 boxes.


