## COLD STORAGE REPORT

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1923.  
GENERAL SUMMARY PUBLISHED Sept. 20th, 1923.

The Butter in storage amounts to 51,259,833 pounds of creamery and 899,034 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 32.37% in the case of creamery and 103.17% for dairy over the holdings on the same date last year. Comparisons with last month show an increase of 20.36% in creamery and 24.26% in dairy.

Butterine stocks are now 1,452,356 pounds, an increase of 675.26% over last year and 182.72% over last month.

Cheese in storage amounts to 20,198,184 pounds being a decrease of 4.59% from previous year and an increase of 9% over August holdings.

Eggs in cold storage total 14,431,151 dozen, other than cold storage 782,312 dozen and frozen 850,669 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks of eggs to have decreased 11.97% from last September holdings and 5.02% from last month; other than cold storage eggs have increased 109.75% from last year and decreased 24.45% from last month; frozen eggs show a decrease of 36.03% from last year and an increase of 13.04% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: 6,546,792 pounds of fresh frozen; 2,871,681 pounds of not frozen; 2,264,165 pounds of dry salted; 5,651,596 pounds of sweet pickled and 8,852,770 pounds of pork in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen pork stocks to have increased 63.63% over last year and decreased 26.87% from last month; not frozen pork shows an increase of 25.25% from last year and 3.50% from last month; dry salted stocks show an increase of 13.90% over last year and a decrease of 41.47% from last month; sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 8.77% from last year and 6.30% from last month; Pork in process of cure shows a decrease of 10.85% from last year and 2.67% from last month.

The Lard in storage amounts to 2,714,097 pounds, an increase of 62.32% over last year and a decrease of 20.41% from last month.

Beef Stocks amount to 3,789,910 pounds of fresh frozen, 4,202,255 pounds of fresh not frozen, 186,111 pounds of cured, 112,540 pounds of beef in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen beef to have decreased by 43.25% from holdings of last September and 7.34% from last month; not frozen stocks show an increase of 26.94% from last year and 33.28% from last month; cured beef shows an increase of 34.35% over last year and a decrease of 29.56% from last month; beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 58.10% from last year and 15.65% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 753,458 pounds of which 535,899 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have increased 26.38% from last year and decreased 14.50% from last month; not frozen stocks show a decrease of 39.55% from last year and an increase of 102.02% from last month.

Stocks of Poultry are as follows:- Broilers, 54,506 pounds, chickens 86,165 pounds, fowl 140,714 pounds, ducks 77,236 pounds, geese 98,812 pounds, turkeys 417.085 pounds and unclassified 161,699 pounds. The total of 1,036,217 pounds shows an increase of 44.79% from last year and 35.67% decrease from last month.

Fish shows an increase of 16.95% from last month in frozen stocks and other in Cold Storage shows an increase of 5.57% over last month.

There are 3,603,026 pounds of condensed milk; 7,299,135 pounds of evaporated milk; 146,281 pounds of whole milk powder and 684,097 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have increased 69.22% over last year and 20.70% over last month, evaporated milk shows an increase of 28.41% over last year and 11.80% over last month; whole milk powder shows a decrease of 42.04% from last year and an increase of 39.61% over last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 53.09% from last year and 20% increase over last month.

Apple stocks show 387 barrels, an increase of 334.85% over last month and a decrease of 97.08% from last year; 2,376 boxes of apples, a decrease of 5.81% from last month and 7.59% from last year.
