COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - NOVEMBER 1, 1934

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 33,262,143 pounds of creamery and 595,167 pounds of dairy. Comparisons with October 1 show a decrease of 6.19% in creamery butter and a decrease of 6.90% in dairy while comparisons with November 1 of last year show increases of 20.13% and 6.23% respectively.

Cheese stocks show 22,468,981 pounds being a decrease of 22.85% from last month and an increase of 39.20% over last year.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 3,635,100 dozen; other than cold storage 457,353 and frozen eggs 821,811 pounds. Comparative figures show decreases from last month as follows:- in cold storage 33.82%; other than cold storage 19.34%, and frozen eggs 34.16%; while comparisons with last year figures show a decrease of 9.26 in eggs in cold storage; an increase of 54.03% in other than cold storage and a decrease of 39.78% in frozen eggs.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,653,682 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,721,233 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,823,193 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,402,506 pounds; and in process of cure 10,552,876 pounds. Comparative figures with last month show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 32.84%; fresh, not frozen show an increase of 7.54%; cured, dry salted show a decrease of 14.03%; cured, sweet pickled show a decrease of 5.81% and in process of cure an increase of .80%. Comparisons with last year's figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 191.40%; fresh, not frozen show a decrease of 14.55%; cured, dry salted an increase of 18.65%; cured, sweet pickled an increase of 25.14 and in process of cure an increase of 37.02%.

Lard stocks show 1,937,000 pounds in store, being a decrease of 58.54% from last month and an increase of 25.77 over last year.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 14,146,955 pounds; fresh, not frozen 6,126,703 pounds; cured 195,035 pounds and in process of cure 199,633 pounds. Comparisons with last month show increases of 57.17% in fresh frozen stocks and 32.20% in not frozen; while cured stocks show a decrease of 36.56% and in process of cure a decrease of 19.71%. Comparisons with last year's figures show increases of 24.10% in fresh frozen stocks and 13.56% in fresh, not frozen; cured stocks show a decrease of 16.45% and in process of cure an increase of 74.57%.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,393,262 pounds of fresh frozen and 505,953 pounds of not frozen, being an increase of 83.30% in fresh frozen and a decrease of 8.30% in not frozen, as compared with last month's figures.

Mutton and lamb stocks show 3,599,713 pounds of fresh frozen and 420,778 pounds of not frozen. Comparisons with last month's figures show increases of 325.36% and 39.69% respectively, while comparisons with last year show frozen stocks to have increased 50.55% and net frozen stocks decreased 24.63%.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 220,613 pounds; chickens 514,592 pounds; fowl 423,042 pounds; ducks 43,981 pounds; geese 59,739 pounds; turkeys 76,245 pounds and unclassified 243,890 pounds. The total of 1,585,303 pounds show increases of 83.57% and 53.88% over last month and last year respectively.

Fish stocks show 19,765,871 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,948,409 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 5.85% over last month and 13.11% over last year; while other fish in cold storage show a decrease of 30.17% from last month and increase of 30.85% over last year.

Milk stocks amount to 3,575,809 pounds of condensed milk; 5,199,557 pounds of evaporated milk; 106,181 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,029,258 pounds of skim milk powder. Compared with last month's figures increases are shown as follows:- condensed milk 15.92%; evaporated milk 25.03%; whole milk powder 35.03% and skim milk powder 21.87%. Compared with last year's figures condensed milk shows a decrease of 22.88%; evaporated milk a decrease of 21.53%; whole milk powder an increase of 10.70% and skim milk powder a decrease of 3.05%.

Apples in storage totalled 25,389 barrels and 136,863 boxes. Apples in barrels show an increase of 481.64% over last month and a decrease of 44.54% from last year; while apples in boxes show increases of 888.46% over last month and 36.09% over last year.

Small fruits in storage are as follows:- raspberries 152 tons and 677 crates; strawberries 66 tons and 1,670 crates; cherries 765 crates; grapes 245 $\frac{1}{2}$ tons and 3,558 crates; pears 175 $\frac{1}{2}$ tons and 4,617 crates and peaches 65 crates.
