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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS FEBRUARY 1, 1924

GENERAL SUMMARY

PUBLISHED FEBRUARY 21, 1924.

The butter in storage amounts to 11,973,325 pounds of creamery and 303,468 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be an increase of 14.98% in creamery and 152.92% in dairy from the amounts held in storage for the corresponding date last year. Comparisons with last month show a decrease of 26.71% in creamery and 4.31% in dairy butter.

Oleomargarine stocks are now 123,210 pounds, a decrease of 37.71% from last year and 73.38% from last month.

Cheese in storage shows 11,842,030 pounds showing an increase of 319.62% over last year's stocks and a decrease of 17.56% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage show a total of 433,564 dozen; other than cold storage 160,030 dozen and frozen 825,256 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease in cold storage eggs of 13.15% from last year and 67.28% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 29.41% from last year and 41.44% from last month; frozen eggs show an increase of 47.41% over last year and 12.79% decrease from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 15,940,199 pounds; fresh not frozen 4,551,454 pounds; cured dry salted 4,057,258 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,387,625 pounds; in process of cure 11,482,469 pounds. Comparative figures show frozen pork to have increased 23.39% from last year and 70.56% over last month; pork not frozen shows an increase of 62.20% over last year and 44.06% over last month; cured dry salted shows an increase of 67.37% over last year and 79.19% over last month; cured sweet pickled shows a decrease of 23.95% from last year and 17.48% from last month; pork in process of cure shows an increase of 28.67% from last year and 7.15% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,232,396 pounds being an increase of 40.71% over last year's stocks and 37.87% over last month's.

Beef stocks amount to 12,235,724 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,702,208 pounds of fresh not frozen; 134,909 pounds of cured and 197,242 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen beef to have decreased 26.62% from last year and 31.64% from last month; not frozen beef shows a decrease of 16.91% from last year and an increase of 38.33% from last month; cured beef shows a decrease of 66.88% from last February and 15.44% from last month; beef in process of cure shows an increase of .39% from last year and 35.79% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 4,857,053 pounds of which 4,664,161 pounds are frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 21.41% from last year and increased .77% over last month; not frozen stocks show a decrease of 4.22% from last year and an increase of 4.95% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 283,061 pounds; chickens 2,244,002 pounds; fowl 995,648 pounds; ducks 150,427 pounds; geese 151,112 pounds; turkeys 686,580 pounds and unclassified 1,753,063 pounds. The total of 6,265,913 pounds shows an increase of 10.48% over last year and a decrease of 4.20% from last month.

Fish stocks show 15,651,529 pounds of fresh frozen, being a decrease of 12.73% from last month, and 2,012,064 pounds of other in cold storage which is 36.82% less than last month.

There are 1,722,006 pounds of condensed milk; 3,335,111 pounds of evaporated milk; 54,622 pounds of whole milk powder; and 678,840 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have increased 83.58% over last February and decreased 14.03% from last month; evaporated milk stocks show an increase of 41.33% over last year and a decrease of 20.43% from last month; whole milk powder stocks show a decrease of 63.38% from last year and an increase of 19.34% over last month; skim milk powder shows a decrease of 128.78% over last year and .51% over last month.

There are 63,140 barrels of apples, an increase of 5.47% over last year and 7.19% decrease from last month, and 126,311 boxes an increase of 2.82% over last year and a decrease of 23.12% from last month.
