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## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - MARCH 1, 1924.

## GENERAL SUMMARY

PUBLISHED MARCH 22nd, 1924.

The butter in storage amounts to 7,605,846 pounds of creamery and 312,387 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show this to be a decrease of 36.48% in the case of creamery and an increase of 2.76% in dairy from the amount held in storage on February 1st. Comparisons with last year show creamery butter stocks to have increased 37.28% and dairy 48.09%.

Cheese stocks show 9,906,647 pounds being a decrease of 16.32% over last month and an increase of 11.45% over last year.

Eggs in cold storage show 122,522 dozen, other than cold storage 353,736 dozen and frozen 632,120 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have decreased 72.38% from last month and increased 72.58% over last year; other than cold storage stocks show an increase of 117.62% over last month and 137.65% over last year; frozen eggs show a decrease of 23.31% from last month and an increase of 73.29% over last March.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 20,839,757 pounds; fresh not frozen 5,205,675 pounds; cured dry salted 5,250,928 pounds; cured sweet pickled 8,960,716 pounds; in process of cure 12,872,076 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 31.10% over last month and 69.19% over last year; fresh not frozen pork shows an increase of 12.98% over last month and 56.35% over last March; cured dry salted increased 29.46% over February stocks and 155.30% over last year; cured sweet pickled stocks show an increase of 40.08% over last month and a decrease of 3.23% from last year; pork in process of cure shows an increase of 10.49% over last month and 70.30% over last year.

Lard stocks show 3,406,350 pounds being an increase of 4.85% over February and 57.83% over last March.

Beef stocks show 9,605,579 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,435,470 pounds of fresh not frozen; 111,552 pounds of cured and 136,190 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 22.19% from previous month and 18.90% from last year; not frozen stocks show an increase of 12.94% from last month and 11.33% from last year; cured beef stocks show a decrease of 26.80% from February and 69.23% from last March; beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 31.95% from last month and 23.83% from last year.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 3,675,811 pounds of frozen and 274,492 pounds of not frozen. The total of 3,950,303 pounds shows a decrease of 18.97% from last month's stocks and 21.76% from last year's.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 281,791 pounds; chickens 2,214,172 pounds; fowl 902,393 pounds; ducks 128,832 pounds; geese 149,845 pounds; turkeys 1,016,702 pounds; unclassified 945,766 pounds. The total of 5,639,551 pounds shows a decrease of 11.52% from last month and an increase of 11.94% over last March stocks.

Fish stocks show 11,551,688 pounds of fresh frozen which is a decrease of 1.81% from last month and 1,700,245 pounds of other in cold storage which is a decrease of 14.19% from February.

Milk stocks show 967,999 pounds of condensed milk; 3,100,266 pounds of evaporated milk; 62,950 pounds of whole milk powder and 786,923 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have decreased 43.79% from last month and increased 39.35% over last year; evaporated milk shows a decrease of 7.04% from February and an increase of 30.24% over last March; whole milk powder shows an increase of 15.25% over last month and 75.75% over last year; skim milk powder shows an increase of 15.92% over last month and 153.14% over last year.

Apples in storage show 14,303 barrels which is a decrease of 34.59% from February and an increase of 1.72% over the stocks of last March; 97,077 boxes which is a decrease of 23.14% from last month and an increase of 35.82% over last year.

There are 700½ tons of raspberries and 110½ tons of strawberries reported as being in storage on March 1st.
