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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - APRIL 1, 1924.GENERAL SUMMARYPublished April 23rd, 1924.

The butter in storage amounts to 4,127,660 pounds of creamery and 166,084 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show decreases of 45.95% and 48.51% respectively from amounts in store on March 1. Comparisons with last year show increases of 31.51% and 370.45% respectively.

Cheese stocks show 8,607,110 pounds being a decrease of 13.14% from last month and an increase of 527.54% over last year.

Eggs in cold storage show 479,826 dozen; other than cold storage 425,842 dozen and frozen 448,498 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 284.90% over last month and 33.60% over last year; other than cold storage stocks show increases of 21.65% over last month and 33.28% over last year while frozen eggs show a decrease of 29.72% from last month and an increase of 86.96% over last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 25,046,641 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,993,240 pounds; cured dry salted 3,593,297 pounds; cured sweet pickled 9,511,304 pounds; in process of cure 14,383,368 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 25.92% over last month and 59.32% over last year; fresh not frozen pork shows decreases of 41.74% from last month and 19.60% from last year; cured dry salted decreased 30.81% from March and increased 103.71% over last year; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 5.58% over last month and 24.18% over last year; pork in process of cure shows increase of 6.57% over last month and 53.45% over last year.

Lard stocks show 3,861,723 pounds being an increase of 14.46% over March and 72.48% over last April.

Beef stocks show 7,434,267 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,276,504 pounds of fresh not frozen; 179,716 pounds of cured and 252,608 pounds in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased .56% from previous month and 28.11% from last year; not frozen stocks show decreases of 39.45% from last month and 15.81% from last year; cured stocks show an increase of 62.04% from March and a decrease of 56.93% from last April; beef in process of cure shows an increase of 85.48% over last month and a decrease of 7.20% from last year.

Mutton and lamb stocks show 3,018,273 pounds of frozen and 109,927 pounds of not frozen. The total of 3,128,200 pounds is a decrease of 17.76% from last month's stocks and 21.47% from last year's stocks.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 179,479 pounds; chickens 1,776,608; fowl 777,526 pounds; ducks 108,578 pounds; geese 135,566 pounds; turkeys 876,208 pounds; unclassified 960,236 pounds. The total of 4,814,201 pounds shows a decrease of 11.98% from last month and an increase of 3.30% over last April.

Fish stocks show 11,800,610 pounds of fresh frozen and 1,638,733 pounds of other in cold storage. Comparisons with last month's figures show decreases of 12.03% and 19.45% respectively.

Milk stocks show 1,166,739 pounds of condensed milk; 3,477,234 pounds of evaporated milk; 172,502 pounds of whole milk powder and 998,481 pounds of skim milk powder. Comparative figures show condensed milk stocks to have increased 20.53% over last month and 128.93% over last year; evaporated milk shows increases of 12.16% over March and 41.38% over last April; whole milk powder shows increases of 174.03% over last month and 9.21% over last year; skim milk powder shows increases of 26.28% over last month and 156.80% over last year.

Apples in storage shows 29,132 barrels which is a decrease of 29.47% from March and an increase of 42.89% over the stocks of last April. There are also 65,330 boxes of apples in storage, a decrease of 32.73% from last month and an increase of 26.72% over last year.

There are 25 3/5 tons and 147 crates of raspberries in storage and 60 4/25 tons and 613 crates of strawberries in storage.
