COLD STORAGE BILLINGS - JULY 1, 1924.
GENERAL SUMMARY.

The butter in storage amounts to 15,758,203 pounds of creamery and 329,815 pounds of dairy. Comparisons with June 1 show increases of 191.81% and 120.17% respectively and comparisons with July 1 of last year show increases of 24.45% and 41.70% respectively.

Cheese stocks show 22,869,777 pounds having increased 84.72% over last month and 93.19 over last year.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 12,574,680 dozen; other than cold storage 752,230 dozen; and frozen eggs 927,398 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 35.35% over last month and to have decreased 15.02 from last year; other than cold storage stocks increased 112.28% over last month and decreased 3.95% from last year; frozen eggs increased 19.95% over last month and 33.70 over last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 23,829,953 pounds; fresh not frozen 4,267,065 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,521,094 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 10,017,211 pounds; and in process of cure 13,537,016 pounds. Comparative figures with last month show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 14.25%; fresh not frozen show an increase of 17.84%; cured, dry salted a decrease of 15.92%; cured, sweet pickled a decrease of 9.01%; and in process of cure a decrease of 2.72%. Comparisons with last year's figures show increases as follows: fresh frozen 101.68%; fresh not frozen 39.11%; cured, dry salted 56.58%; cured, sweet pickled 47.19%; in process of cure 45.11%.

Lard stocks show 6,484,081 pounds in store, being an increase of 19.46% over last month and 119.20% over last year.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 3,373,386 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,920,681 pounds; cured 191,643 pounds; in process of cure 211,304 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks decreased 21.41% from last month and 24.33% from last year; fresh not frozen stocks decreased 9.46% from last month and increased 51.93% over last year; cured stocks increased 47.90% over last month and decreased 31.04% from last year; stocks in process of cure increased 20.03% over last month and 34.45% over last year.

Mutton and lamb stocks show 575,210 pounds of frozen and 131,547 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 49.05% from last month and 45.83% from last year, while not frozen stocks show an increase of 47.11% over last month and 53.49% over last year.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 76,454 pounds; chickens 699,763 pounds; fowl 431,639 pounds; ducks 55,033 pounds; geese 103,425 pounds; turkeys 508,405 pounds; unclassified 167,633 pounds. The total of 2,038,463 pounds show decreases of 22.52% from last month and 59% from last year.

Fish stocks show 12,614,712 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,741,863 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 17.39% and 12.33% over last month and last year respectively, while other fish in cold storage also show increases of 63.50% and 41.11% respectively.

Milk stocks amount to 4,726,033 pounds of condensed milk; 7,153,982 pounds of evaporated milk; 154,493 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,448,815 pounds of skim milk powder. Compared with last month's figures condensed milk increased 36.56%; evaporated milk increased 12.31%; whole milk powder increased 84.34% while skim milk powder shows a decrease of 4.96%. Compared with last year's figures there were increases of 88.07% in condensed milk; 5.02% in evaporated milk; 22.21% in whole milk powder and 145.57% in skim milk powder.

Apples in storage totalled 483 barrels and 5,780 boxes. The apples in barrels decreased 70.35% from last month and increased 654.69% over last year, while apples in boxes decreased 78% from last month and increased 315.23% over last year.

Small fruits in storage are as follows:- raspberries 40½ tons and 20 crates; strawberries 102½ tons and 178 3/5 crates; cherries 7 2/15 tons and 442 crates; pears 1 1/10 tons; peaches 19/20 tons and 64 crates.
