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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - AUGUST 1, 1924

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 27,028,394 pounds of creamery and 537,351 pounds of dairy. Comparisons with July 1, show increases of 75.7% and 91.8% respectively while comparisons with August 1 of last year show an increase of 6.92% in creamery butter and a decrease of 4.10% in dairy butter.

Cheese stocks show 28,986,529 pounds, an increase of 28.01% over last month and 73.05% over last year.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,427,596 dozen; other than cold storage 814,435 dozen; and frozen eggs 253,989 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have increased 24.63% over last month and 3.12% over last year; other than cold storage stocks decreased 16.07% from last month and 53.73% from last year; frozen eggs increased 3.26% over last month and 28.05% over last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 18,381,673 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,489,266 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,810,048 pounds; cured sweet pickled 8,132,237 pounds; in process of cure 11,444,183 pounds. Compared with last month's figures there were decreases as follows:- fresh frozen 22.6%; fresh not frozen 40.63%; cured dry salted 13.87%; cured sweet pickled 16.92%; in process of cure 14.53%. Compared with last year fresh frozen pork increased 106.84%; fresh not frozen increased .73%; cured dry salted decreased 23.34%; cured sweet pickled increased 48.76% and in process of cure increased 26.54%.

Lard stocks amount to 6,409,973 pounds being a decrease of .35% from last month and an increase of 111.27% over last year.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 2,812,578 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,790,357 pounds; cured 247,487 pounds; in process of cure 246,044 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks decreased 14.19% from last month and 28.53% from last year; fresh not frozen stocks decreased 3.92% from last month and increased 34.74% over last year; cured stocks increased 29.14% over last month and decreased 18.00% from last year; stocks in process of cure increased 17.46% over last month and 85.09% over last year.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 433,754 pounds of frozen and 118,983 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 23.60% from last month and 38.52% from last year and not frozen stocks show decreases of 9.31% and 24.06% respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 82,931 pounds; chickens 478,934 pounds; fowl 321,430 pounds; ducks 46,035 pounds; geese 94,228 pounds; turkeys 374,503 pounds; unclassified 100,309 pounds. The total of 1,498,415 pounds shows a decrease of 25.74% from last month and 4.33% from last year.

Fish stocks show 11,608,686 pounds of fresh frozen and 8,112,705 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 2,12% over last month and a decrease of 4.33% from last year; other in cold storage stocks show increases of 125.26% and 233.81% over last month and last year respectively.

Milk stocks amount to 4,527,109 pounds of condensed milk; 8,965,951 pounds of evaporated milk; 34,113 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,374,132 pounds of skim milk powder. Condensed milk stocks decreased 8.44% from last month and increased 31.56% over last year; evaporated milk increased 25.35% over last month and 62.38% over last year; whole milk powder decreased 77.92% from last month and 36.30% from last year; and skim milk powder decreased 5.16% from last month and increased 55.56% over last year.

Apples in storage totalled 294 barrels and 1,466 boxes. Compared with last month there were decreases of 65.01% and 74.64% respectively. Compared with last year's figures apples in barrels showed an increase of 2.50% and apples in boxes a decrease of 45.54%.

Small fruits in storage are as follows:- raspberries 351 $\frac{1}{4}$ tons and 521 crates; strawberries 77 tons and 3,635 crates; loganberries 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ tons; cherries 4 4/5 tons and 572 crates; pears 2 tons and 141 crates; peaches 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ tons and 1,147 crates.
