COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS - SEPTEMBER 1, 1924GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 33,874,160 pounds of creamery and 757,851 pounds of dairy. Comparisons with August 1 show increases of 21.84% and 24.58% respectively and comparison with September 1 of last year show increases of 8.36% and 8.41% respectively.

Cheese stocks show 33,445,223 pounds having increased 15.05% over last month and 65.59% over last year.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,169,291 dozen; other than cold storage 686,088 dozen and frozen eggs 1,091,486 pounds. Comparative figures show cold storage stocks to have decreased 4.01% from last month and to have increased 5.11% over last year, other than cold storage stocks increased 14.60% over last month and decreased 12.30% from last year; frozen eggs decreased 6.09% from last month and increased 28.31% over last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 12,428,075 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,896,347 pounds; cured dry salted 1,819,500 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,505,221 pounds; and in process of cure 11,518,010 pounds. Comparative figures with last month show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 25.31%; fresh not frozen show an increase of 25.26%; cured, dry salted a decrease of 26.30%; cured sweet pickled a decrease of 4.53% and in process of cure a decrease of .79%. Comparisons with last year's figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 89.83%; fresh not frozen an increase of .86%; cured dry salted a decrease of 19.6%; cured sweet pickled an increase of 32.80%; and in process of cure an increase of 30.11%.

Lard stocks show 5,427,764 pounds in store, being a decrease of 5.82% from last month and an increase of 99.98% over last year.

Beef stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,269,552 pounds; fresh not frozen 4,587,105 pounds; cured 304,685 pounds and in process of cure 256,318 pounds. Comparisons with last month show increases as follows: fresh frozen 48.14%; fresh not frozen 36.81%; cured 23.11%; and in process of cure 1.80%. Comparisons with last year's figures also show increases as follows:- fresh frozen 12.66%; fresh, not frozen 9.16%; cured 63.71%; and in process of cure 127.76%.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show 373,829 pounds of frozen and 207,671 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 16.13% from last month and 30.24% from last year; while frozen stocks show an increase of 91.08% over last month and a decrease of 4.54% from last year.


Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 110,578 pounds; chickens 347,755 pounds; fowl 289,991 pounds; ducks 42,801 pounds; poults 83,604 pounds; turkeys 265,266 pounds; unclassified 136,755 pounds. The total of 1,276,770 show a decrease of 22.56% from last month and an increase of 23.21% over last year.

Fish stocks show 17,308,864 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,236,456 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 8.19% over last month and 21.09% over last year; while other fish in cold storage show a decrease of 35.32% from last month and an increase of 102.41% over last year.

Milk stocks amount to 3,356,818 pounds of condensed milk; 9,323,200 pounds of evaporated milk; 120,555 pounds of whole milk powder and 1,369,727 pounds of skim milk powder. Compared with last month's figures condensed milk decreased 22.42%; evaporated milk increased 3.9%; whole milk powder 253.40%; and skim milk powder decreased .32%. Compared with last year's figures condensed milk shows a decrease of 6.83%; evaporated milk an increase of 27.73%; whole milk powder a decrease of 17.59%; and skim milk powder an increase of 100.22%.

Apples in storage totalled 71 barrels and 3,526 boxes. The apples in barrels decreased 75.85% from last month and 81.65% from last year; while apples in boxes increased 140.52% over last month and 48.40% over last year.

Small fruits in storage are as follows:- raspberries 355 4/5 tons and 1,272 crates; strawberries 103 1/3 tons and 3,966 crates; blackberries 17 tons; loganberries 21 tons and 694 crates; cherries 1 ton and 25 crates; grapes 1 ton; pears 9 1/2 tons and 1,185 crates and peaches 3 1/2 tons and 3,150 crates.
