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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, OCTOBER 1, 1925  
GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 21,234,683 pounds of creamery and 419,015 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 40.29% from last year and an increase of 3.91% over last month, and dairy butter shows a decrease of 35.34% from last year and 37.68% from last month.

Cheese stocks show 30,560,458 pounds in store being an increase of 4.91% over last year and 2.10% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,628,329 dozen; other than cold storage 447,195 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,165,944 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase in cold storage eggs of 18.89% over last year and a decrease of 3.18% from last month; other than cold storage eggs decreased 21.59% from last year and 27.91% from last month, and frozen eggs also show decreases of 6.78% from last year and 10.23% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,308,077 pounds; fresh, not frozen, 1,946,514 pounds; cured, dry salted, 1,347,880 pounds; cured, sweet pickled, 6,232,328 pounds; and in process of cure 8,483,306 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 57.04% from last year and 49.94% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks decreased 23.87% from last year and increased 4.47% over last month; cured, dry salted decreased 37.16% from last year and 30.59% from last month; cured, sweet pickled decreased 9.95% from last year and 17.78% from last month and pork in process of cure decreased 19.11% from last year and 8.66% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,638,964 pounds being a decrease of 45.13% from last year and 34.45% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 6,248,942 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,314,812 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 357,361 pounds of cured, and 135,045 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have decreased 31.78% from last year and increased 20.72% over last month; fresh, not frozen shows an increase of 5.88% over last year and 19.21% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 16.25% over last year and 49.15% over last month and beef, in process of cure shows a decrease of 45.83% from last year and 58.35% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 890,633 pounds of fresh frozen and 246,685 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 6.78% over last year and 25.19% over last month; and fresh not frozen veal, shows a decrease of 26.03% from last year and 7.60% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 626,605 pounds of frozen and 250,006 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 26.27% from last year and increased 23.53% over last month; and not frozen stocks show a decrease of 18.18% from last year and an increase of 42.00% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: Broilers, 178,521 pounds; chickens, 384,037 pounds; fowl, 229,499 pounds; ducks, 54,061 pounds; geese 111,276 pounds; turkeys 458,040 pounds; and unclassified 148,763 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 61.22% over last year and a decrease of 19.43% from last month.

Fish stocks show 19,267,729 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,713,031 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of .10% from last year and an increase of 6.25% over last month and other in cold storage stocks show decreases of 35.57% from last year and 11.47% from last month.


