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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1925
GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 16,880,968 pounds of creamery and 275,242 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 49.01% from last year and 19.98% from last month, and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 51.33% from last year and 33.20% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 29,508,181 pounds, showing an increase of 31.27% over last year and a decrease of 3.32% from last month.

Eggs show 10,500,865 dozen in cold storage, 532,920 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,596,278 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 20.61% over last year and a decrease of 33.46% from last month; other than cold storage show an increase of 16.44% over last year and 19.98% over last month, and frozen eggs also show increases of 94.24% over last year and 35.91% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: fresh frozen 2,154,416 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,369,890 pounds; cured, dry salted 988,224 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,482,976 pounds; and in process of cure 7,469,873 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 68.13% from last year and 49.82% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks decreased 13.69% from last year and increased 26.24% over last month; cured, dry salted show decreases of 46.62% from last year and 26.50% from last month; cured, sweet pickled shows a decrease of .11% from last year and an increase of 4.10% over last month and pork, in process of cure shows decreases of 29.31% over last year and 9.56% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,673,216 pounds, and comparative figures show decreases of 16.00% from last year and 35.68% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 9,076,878 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,229,877 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 322,875 pounds of cured and 146,727 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have decreased 36.00% from last year and increased 45.74% over last month; fresh, not frozen shows increases of .19% over last year and 17.07% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 65.56% over last year and a decrease of 9.64% from last month; and in process of cure shows a decrease of 26.87% from last year and an increase of 12.87% over last month.

Veal in storage shows a total of 1,522,016 pounds of fresh, frozen and 415,347 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 5.11% from last year and an increase of 49.33% over last month; while fresh, not frozen veal shows increases of 35.76% over last year and 68.09% over last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 2,761,879 pounds of frozen and 339,083 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.39% from last year and an increase of 341.05% over last month, and not frozen stocks also show a decrease of 19.62% from last year and an increase of 35.52% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers, 219,288 pounds; chickens, 503,933 pounds; fowl, 326,677 pounds; ducks, 26,643 pounds; geese, 94,083 pounds; turkeys 350,939 pounds; unclassified, 212,269 pounds; Total poultry shows increases of 7.92% over last year and 10.80% over last month.

Fish stocks show 21,113,469 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,738,528 pounds of other in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 6.74% over last year and 9.40% over last month and other in cold storage also shows increases of 20.01% over last year and 26.02% over last month.


