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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, DECEMBER 1, 1925  
GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 14,745,697 pounds of creamery and 145,338 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 49.10% from last year and 13.08% from last month, and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 74.06% from last year and 49.31% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 22,115,139 pounds, showing an increase of 26.26% over last year and a decrease of 25.16% from last month.

Eggs show 6,311,924 dozen in cold storage, 377,623 dozen other than cold storage and 1,285,488 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 31.96% over last year and a decrease of 39.91% from last month; other than cold storage show a decrease of 18.74% from last year and 29.35% from last month, and frozen eggs show an increase of 24.88% over last year and a decrease of 19.59% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: fresh frozen 2,855,703 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,383,804 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,121,467 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,226,949 pounds; and in process of cure 7,595,485 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 62.99% from last year and increased 31.17% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks decreased 29.53% from last year and increased 18.43% over last month; cured, dry salted decreased 59.86% from last year and increased 13.20% over last month; cur, sweet pickled shows a decrease of 15.54% from last year and 5.62% from last month, and in process of cure shows a decrease of 17.05% from last year and .13 from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,414,391 pounds and comparative figures show a decrease of 29.00% from last year and 16.89% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 12,949,275 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,033,594 pounds of fresh not frozen; 267,381 pounds of cured and 151,652 pounds of beef in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen-beef to have decreased 41.36% from last year and increased 42.39% over last month; fresh, not frozen shows a decrease of 9.91% from last year and 51.12% from last month; cured beef shows a decrease of 2.16% from last year and 17.20% from last month; and in process of cure shows a decrease of 14.75% from last year and an increase of .22 over last month.

Veal in storage shows a total of 2,002,200 pounds of fresh frozen and 291,588 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.17% from last year and an increase of 51.24% over last month and not frozen stocks show a decrease of 22.99% from last year and 29.42% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 3,674,703 pounds of frozen and 549,669 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 36.84% from last year and an increase of 33.03% over last month, and not frozen stocks show an increase of 108.93% over last year and 61.93% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers, 349,303 pounds; chickens, 1,421,642 pounds; fowl, 547,090 pounds; ducks, 56,401 pounds; geese 132,970 pounds; turkeys, 318,042 pounds; unclassified, 581,466 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 18.25% from last year and an increase of 95.08% over last month.

Fish stocks show 18,601,756 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,834,955 pounds of other in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 7.74% from last year and 17.75% from last month, and other in cold storage shows an increase of 11.84% over last year and 21.47% over last month.


