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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS APRIL 1, 1925

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 5,844,956 pounds of creamery and 341,601 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 41.60% over last year and a decrease of 52.15% from last month, and dairy butter also shows an increase of 45.47% over last year and a decrease of 37.87% from last month.

Cheese stocks show 5,669,617 pounds in store being a decrease of 34.13% from last year and 18.03% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 289,923 dozen; other than cold storage 421,713 dozen and frozen eggs 471,764 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease of 43.75% from last year and an increase of 143.02% over last month in cold storage eggs; other than cold storage show a decrease of .97% from last year and an increase of 25.46% over last month; while frozen eggs show an increase of 5.19% over last year and a decrease of 32.17% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 27,445,163 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,085,293 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,584,636 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 10,457,217 pounds; in process of cure 12,876,016 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 9.57% over last year and 8.16% last month; pork, not frozen show an increase of 3.08% over last year and 9.89% over last month; cured, dry salted shows a decrease of 28.07% from last year and an increase of .84% over last month; cured, sweet pickled shows an increase of 9.95% over last year and 9.80% over last month. Pork in process of cure shows a decrease of 10.48% from last year and .15% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,372,960 pounds being a decrease of 12.66% from last year and an increase of 2.68% over last month.


Beef stocks amount to 10,377,553 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,028,978 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 348,321 pounds of cured and 128,709 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show frozen beef to have increased 39.59% over last year and decreased 20.72% from last month; beef, not frozen shows an increase of 22.97% over last year and 11.39% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 93.82% over last year and 59.56% over last month; beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 49.05% from last year and 58.30% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 808,464 pounds of fresh frozen and 129,085 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Compared with last month's figures fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 39.15% while fresh, not frozen shows an increase of 21.86%.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 3,726,281 pounds of frozen and 85,928 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have increased 23.46% over last year and decreased 20.61% from last month; not frozen stocks show a decrease of 21.83% from last year and 14.83% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 248,717 pounds; chickens 2,339,537 pounds; fowl 1,107,426 pounds, ducks 98,47 pounds; geese 238,734 pounds; turkeys 1,355,885 pounds; unclassified 680,467 pounds. The total of 6,070,779 pounds shows an increase of 26.10% over last year and a decrease of 17.48% from last month.


Fish stocks show 8,716,863 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,221,382 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 26.13% from last year and 17.79% from last month and other in cold storage shows an increase of 35.55% over last year and a decrease of 39.16% from last month.
