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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1925

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 2,917,716 pounds of creamery and 186,931 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 48.50% from last year and an increase of 28.92% over last month, and dairy butter shows an increase of 17.83% over last year and a decrease of 5.74% from last month.

Cheese stocks show 15,421,532 pounds in store being an increase of 24.52% over last year and 46.55% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 9,829,201 dozen; other than cold storage 602,539 dozen and frozen eggs 649,560 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase of 6.17% over last year and 119.75% over last month in cold storage eggs; other than cold storage show a decrease of 18.53% from last year and 12.35% from last month and frozen eggs show a decrease of 15.95% from last year and an increase of 26.87% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 29,557,895 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,215,796 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,369,766 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 8,975,117 pounds; in process of cure 12,248,814 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 5.38% over last year and decreased 4.61% from last month; pork, not frozen shows a decrease of 11.79% from last year and an increase of 2.15% over last month; cured, dry salted shows a decrease of 43.62% from last year and 24.26% from last month; cured, sweet pickled shows a decrease of 19.47% from last year and 9.71% from last month and in process of cure a decrease of 12.83% from last year and an increase of 6.63% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,242,359 pounds being a decrease of 4.11% from last year and an increase of 16.99% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 7,210,984 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,662,630 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 402,869 pounds of cured beef and 184,502 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have increased 66.80% over last year and decreased 22.34% from last month; beef, not frozen shows a decrease of 16.24% from last year and 2.23% from last month; cured beef shows an increase of 210.17% over last year and 20.81% over last month and in process of cure shows an increase of 4.80% over last year and 9.41% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 477,094 pounds of fresh frozen and 243,593 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Compared with last month's figures fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 11.47% and fresh, not frozen also shows a decrease of 30.67%.

Mutton and lamb stocks show a total of 1,577,373 pounds of frozen and 85,755 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen shows to have increased 37.58% over last year and decreased 36.35% from last month; while not frozen stocks show a decrease of 10.81% from last year and an increase of 1.74% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 157,725 pounds; chickens 1,495,882 pounds; fowl 666,147 pounds; ducks 78,945 pounds; geese 147,363 pounds; turkeys 1,030,235 pounds; unclassified 407,408 pounds. The total of 3,983,705 pounds shows an increase of 50.20% over last year and a decrease of 15.31% from last month.

Fish stocks show 11,044,007 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,102,068 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 4.55% over last year and 8.66% over last month and other in cold storage also shows an increase of 94.78% over last year and 5.43% over last month.


