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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS JULY 1, 1925.

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 11,043,035 pounds of creamery and 365,376 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 30.01% over last year and 299.23% over last month, and dairy butter also shows an increase of 10.23% over last year and 95.14% over last month.

Cheese stocks show 20,697,633 pounds in store being a decrease of 9.53% from last year and an increase of 35.36% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 13,203,963 dozen; other than cold storage 568,466 dozen and frozen eggs 971,996 pounds. Comparative figures show an increase of 4.02% over last year and 37.44% over last month in cold storage eggs; other than cold storage show a decrease of 26.71% from last year and 5.89% from last month and frozen eggs show an increase of 4.81% over last year and 49.84% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 22,753,064 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,637,106 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,343,704 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 10,311,860 pounds; in process of cure 11,053,921 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 5.44% from last year and 22.33% from last month; pork, not frozen shows a decrease of 38.79% from last year and 15.93% from last month; cured, dry salted shows a decrease of 5.37% from last year and an increase of +2.27% over last month; cured, sweet pickled shows an increase of 1.65% over last year and 19.92% over last month and in process of cure shows a decrease of 18.39% from last year and 9.76% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,634,441 pounds being a decrease of 13.87% from last year and an increase of 9.36% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 5,076,444 pounds of fresh frozen; 2,869,005 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 217,446 pounds of cured and 229,954 pounds of beef in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have increased 49.58% over last year and decreased 29.39% from last month; beef, not frozen shows a decrease of 27.87% from last year and 20.56% from last month; cured beef shows an increase of 13.46% over last year and a decrease of 46.01% from last month and beef, in process of cure shows an increase of 8.67% over last year and 31.97% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 653,955 pounds of fresh frozen and 287,615 pounds of fresh not frozen. Compared with last month's figures fresh frozen veal shows an increase of 34.20% and not frozen veal also shows an increase of 10.87%.

Mutton and Lamb stocks show a total of 322,330 pounds of frozen and 104,155 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have increased 58.49% over last year and decreased 40.83% from last month; while not frozen stocks show a decrease of 21.30% from last year and an increase of 18.06% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 120,105 pounds; chickens 1,220,392 pounds; fowl 462,191 pounds; ducks 55,707 pounds; geese 135,888 pounds; turkeys 938,684 pounds; unclassified 263,158 pounds. The total of 3,202,425 pounds shows an increase of 56.35% over last year and a decrease of 18.71% from last month.

Fish stocks show 13,512,149 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,707,544,325,815 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 7.11% over last year and 22.35% over last month and other in cold storage also shows increases of 57.76% over last year and 39.48% over last month.
