COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1st, 1925

General Summary

The butter in storage amounts to 15,789,492 pounds of creamery and 488,751 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 43.26% from last year and an increase of 43.21% over last month, and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 18.99% from last year and an increase of 42.67% over last month.

Cheese stocks show 23,231,670 pounds in store being a decrease of 19.99% from last year and an increase of 12.01% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,683,276 dozen; other than cold storage 868,532 dozen and frozen eggs 841,885 pounds. Comparative figures show a decrease of 5.93% from last year and an increase of 10.93% over last month in cold storage eggs; other than cold storage show an increase of 41.17% over last year and 63.35% over last month and frozen eggs show a decrease of 27.42% from last year and 13.39% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 16,174,645 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,171,953 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,221,005 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 1,922,874 pounds; in process of cure 10,005,293 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 12.03% from last year and 28.93% from last month; pork, not frozen shows a decrease of 12.80% from last year and 17.38% from last month; cured, dry salted shows a decrease of 20.97% from last year and 33.58% from last month; cured, sweet pickled shows an increase of 9.72% over last year and a decrease of 13.22% from last month, and in process of cure shows a decrease of 12.57% from last year and 9.71% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,918,973 pounds being a decrease of 23.33% from last year and 12.90% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 4,379,150 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,093,139 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 209,551 pounds of cured and 226,796 pounds of beef in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen beef to have increased 54.73% over last year and decreased 13.70% from last month; beef, not frozen shows an increase of 7.93% over last year and 42.93% over last month; cured beef shows a decrease of 15.21% from last year and 3.49% from last month, and beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 7.82% from last year and 2.59% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 556,076 pounds of fresh frozen and 316,496 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Compared with last month's figures fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 14.74%, while not frozen veal shows an increase of 4.44%.

Butter and Lamb stocks show 673,759 pounds of frozen and 156,872 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have increased 52.88% over last year and decreased 26.95% from last month; while not frozen stocks show an increase of 31.84% over last year and 54.95% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 121,050 pounds; chickens 770,777 pounds; fowl 339,274 pounds; ducks 45,661 pounds; geese 138,993 pounds; turkeys 781,752 pounds, unclassified 211,549 pounds. The total of 2,409,086 pounds shows an increase of 58.94% over last year and a decrease of 26.11% from last month.

Fish stocks show 15,461,707 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,187,793 pounds of other in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 22.58% over last year and 14.75% from last month, and other in cold storage shows a decrease of 36.06% from last year and an increase of 22.19% over last month.
