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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, January 1, 1926,

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 9,573,469 pounds of creamery and 140,957 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 56.84% from last year and 32.80% from last month, and dairy butter also shows decreases of 67.96% from last year and 3.01% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 22,410,362 pounds, showing increases of 57.82% over last year and 1.32% over last month.

Eggs show 3,616,346 dozen in cold storage, 370,165 dozen, other than cold storage and 580,656 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 54.87% over last year and a decrease of 42.30% from last month; other than cold storage show an increase of 29.75% over last year and a decrease of 2.72% from last month; and frozen eggs decreases of 48.98% from last year and 54.76% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 3,911,913 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,446,619 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,334,716 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,536,693 pounds; and in process of cure 7,459,314 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 77.14% from last year and increased 37.03% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 23.37% from last year and 15.39% from last month; cured, dry salted have decreased 72.42% from last year and increased 18.99% over last month; cured, sweet pickled show a decrease of 28.09% from last year and an increase of 4.96% over last month; and in process of cure a decrease of 30.57% from last year and an increase of 11.37% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,154,756 pounds and comparative figures show a decrease of 27.00% from last year and an increase of 52.26% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 14,101,747 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,611,556 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 289,694 pounds of cured beef; and 300,334 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 41.86% from last year and increased 8.90% over last month; fresh, not frozen show decreases of 7.03% from last year and 23.78% from last month; cured beef shows increases of 10.87% over last year and 8.35% over last month; and in process of cure a decrease of 2.23% from last year and an increase of 98.07% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,784,527 pounds of fresh frozen and 178,370 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.26% from last year and 11.14% from last month, and fresh, not frozen show decreases of 38.26% from last year and 37.18% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 4,702,590 pounds of frozen and 153,622 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 22.25% from last year and an increase of 27.97% over last month, and not frozen stocks show decreases of 33.30% from last year and 72.05% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers, 367,397 pounds; chickens, 2,843,943 pounds; fowl, 1,020,203 pounds; ducks, 182,436 pounds; geese 126,074 pounds; turkeys 1,075,541 pounds; unclassified, 1,114,371 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 15.56% from last year and an increase of 99.12% over last month.

Fish stocks show 13,578,183 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,895,091 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 10.64% from last year and 25.88% from last month; and other in cold storage also shows decreases of 8.06% from last year and 33.09% from last month.


