COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, OCTOBER 1, 1926

The butter in storage amounts to 32,026,179 pounds of creamery and 578,400 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 50.49% over last year and a decrease of 1.92% from last month and dairy butter also shows an increase of 37.08% over last year and a decrease of 55.06% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 38,251,790 pounds in store showing an increase of 25.16% over last year and a decrease of 7.91% from last month.

Eggs show 13,154,965 dozen in cold storage; 515,271 dozen other than cold storage and 1,574,917 pounds of frozen eggs. Eggs in cold storage show decreases of 6.38% from last year and 10.31% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage show an increase of 15.22% over last year and a decrease of 17.40% from last month, while frozen eggs show increases of 35.08% and 26.83% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen, 3,599,143 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,345,582 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,154,338 pounds, cured sweet pickled, 5,783,461 pounds; in process of cure, 2,840,478 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 26.43% over last year and decreased 26.90% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 49.27% over last year and 36.38% over last month; cured, dry salted when compared with last year show an increase of 57.03% and a decrease of 4.27% when compared with last month; cured, sweet pickled also shows an increase of 6.75% over last year and a decrease of 16.06% from last month and stocks in process of cure show increases of 15.89% and 4.05% over last year and last month, respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,969,132 pounds, showing an increase of 49.45% over last year and a decrease of 28.79% from last month.

Beef stocks amounted to 3,485,253 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,957,796 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 264,676 pounds of cured beef and 350,675 pounds of stocks, in process of cure. When compared with last year's figures fresh frozen beef shows a decrease of 44.47% and when compared with last month, an increase of 4.47%; beef not frozen shows increases of 10.76% over last year and 22.52% over last month; cured beef shows decreases of 25.94% from last year and 13.82% from last month; while stocks in process of cure show increases of 159.52% and 5.98% over last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,053,521 pounds of fresh frozen and 643,536 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh stocks show increases of 18.85% over last year and 17.42% over last month and fresh veal, not frozen also shows increases of 159.61% and 124.05% over last year and last month respectively.

Mutton & Lamb stocks total 403,265 pounds of frozen and 730,652 pounds of stocks, not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 36.01% from last year and an increase of 150.26% over last month, while stocks not frozen show increases of 29.91% over last year and 39.08% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 145,670 pounds; chickens 267,113 pounds; fowl 211,723 pounds; ducks 83,504 pounds; geese 22,406 pounds; turkeys 20,897 pounds; unclassified 70,642 pounds. Comparative figures show decreases in total poultry of 35.87% from last year and 9.15% from last month.

Fish stocks show 13,373,346 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 4,780,855 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 5.91% from last year and an increase of 15.58% over last month, while other fish in cold storage shows increases of 25.80% and 12.73% over last year and last month respectively.
