COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 20, 1926

The butter in storage amounts to 27,887,246 pounds of creamery and 621,421 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 64.49% over last year and a decrease of 13.08% from last month while dairy butter shows increases of 123.22% and 8.37% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 34,507,667 pounds in store showing an increase of 16.79% over last year and a decrease of 9.79% from last month.

Eggs show 7,847,593 dozen in cold storage; 525,947 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,404,060 pounds of frozen eggs. Eggs in cold storage show decreases of 25.42% from last year and 40.35% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage show a decrease of 1.46% from last year and an increase of 2.07% over last month, while frozen eggs show decreases of 12.04% from last year and 10.85% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,835,035 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,918,009 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,623,729 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,325,843 pounds; and in process of cure 9,414,934 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 114.30% over last year and decreased 13.58% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 18.93% over last year and a decrease of .94% from last month; cured, dry salted also shows an increase of 59.35% over last year and a decrease of 24.65% from last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 5.52% from last year and 6.75% from last month, and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 24.07% over last year and a decrease of 4.72% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,280,794 pounds, showing an increase of 34.17% over last year and a decrease of 42.54% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 7,764,602 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,345,138 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 282,188 pounds of cured beef and 346,759 pounds of stocks, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 14.79% from last year and an increase of 124.03% over last month; stocks not frozen show increases of .47% over last year and 6.50% over last month; cured beef shows a decrease of 12.62% from last year and an increase of 6.62% over last month, while stocks in process of cure show an increase of 129.68% over last year and a decrease of 1.12% from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,614,033 pounds of fresh frozen and 599,350 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 22.16% over last year and 52.62% over last month, and fresh stocks, not frozen show an increase of 44.72% over last year and a decrease of 6.87% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 1,906,666 pounds of frozen and 574,253 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 31.10% from last year and an increase of 373.38% over last month, while not frozen stocks show increases of 63.99% over last year and 73.67% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 234,894 pounds; chickens 526,006 pounds; fowl 544,571 pounds; ducks 114,088 pounds; geese 27,955 pounds; turkeys 156,441 pounds; unclassified 119,765 pounds. Comparative figures show total poultry to have decreased from last year, 1.46%, and increased 71.48% over last month.

Fish stocks show 21,894,778 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 3,016,732 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 3.42% over last year and 14.65% over last month, while other fish in cold storage shows decreases of 37.20% and 36.90% last year and last month respectively.


